*From Our Pastor, Fr. Fausto...***My Dear Friends,**

**COVID-19 and the Delta variant continue to pose significant health concerns.** However, the most recent statewide data from the Florida Department of Health is encouraging. Both the most recent New Case Positivity Rate (now 16.8% from 20.1%) and weekly death rate have been decreasing.

Expanded treatment options have kept many patients from being hospitalized. Monoclonal Antibody Treatments (MAB) for COVID-19 may prevent severe illness, hospitalization and death among high-risk individuals. As mentioned last week, this intravenous outpatient treatment is now available in Sarasota County. Individuals 12 years and older who are high-risk and that have contracted or been exposed to COVID-19, may be eligible for this treatment. Contact your healthcare provider to see if you are a candidate for this therapy.

We continue to pray for those who are ill with this virus and for the families, loved ones and healthcare workers who are ministering to, and caring for these patients.

**Happy Labor Day Weekend!** Enjoy it, and remember, if you drink, **do not drive!** Have a designated driver who does not drink, and leave the driving to her/him. Our parish office will be closed tomorrow, Monday, September 6, and the Masses are at 7:30 a.m., 8:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. There will be no Noon or 5:30 p.m. Mass.

**Jesus performs one of His great miracles in today's gospel, but in a way that seems so peculiar and alien from our modern obsessively hygienic society.** I remember an altar girl remark to me: *"Today's gospel is gross."* Well, maybe so, but remember that this is a dramatic ritual-like healing, in which Jesus, traveling in a Pagan, Greek-speaking country, uses a strange gesture and an Aramaic word to impress the Pagan crowd. Note how Jesus unites Himself to His Father in heaven before the healing. Two lessons are taught here:

The respect for rituals (symbolic actions) is the first one; and blessedly we Catholics experience the mysterious presence of God in our liturgical actions, in the silence, gestures, songs, readings, postures... For instance, the sign of the cross is a powerful reminder to us and to the rest of humankind that we are one with the crucified Lord and that we are willing to live and even die for Jesus. Another example is the three little crosses that we sign ourselves before the proclamation of the gospel, meaning that we are willing to open our minds to the good news of Jesus (cross on the forehead), that we will have the guts to spread and proclaim that message to the world (cross on the lips), and that we open our hearts to his infinite and crazy love for us, willing on our part to love one another (cross on the heart).

The second lesson is to get together with God (prayer) before taking any decision or action, as Jesus did, sighing aloud and looking up to reach His Father's glory, before the healing. Let us make it a habit to pray to God before we start our day, or eat, or study, or work, or drive or write on the computer. And we must learn how to talk to God, not only using formal prayers, but dialoging with Him. We must talk to God in the same way that we talk to our parents, our children, our spouses, our friends: directly and gently.

Sometimes it is a long conversation, as when dad and son talk about an important choice; at other times, just a look at a spouse, who will understand immediately its

meaning; at other times, it is just a short sentence like *"I love you or thank you God..."* This is active prayer. At times, it is contemplative prayer; like two lovers tenderly resting in an embrace without uttering a word; at times, it is just staying in the same room, doing different tasks, but happy to be together. This is the most common prayer which we do when, in state of grace, we live and sleep and work and so forth in the presence of the Triune God, in whose presence we are immersed.

**I am sure that many of you, Dear Parishioners, have experienced the homeless people who beg you for money around St. Martha Church.** Some of you may feel compassionate, guilty or threatened by them. Please remember that every first Sunday of the month you give to Caritas volunteers (today is Caritas Sunday!) who give food, tickets for the bus, work boots and, in case of an emergency, assistance to partially help with some utilities and medicine. You wonder why some of these people, who seem to be in the fullness of youth or maturity, beg for money! Mental health is partly to blame, but substance addiction is the main culprit! In giving money to them, we keep them in their addiction! When they approach you for money (and the stories they tell you are heart-rending ... if you know what I mean) just tell them: *"Gee, I'm giving, or I've just given money to Caritas... go to them, and ask them for food, etc. ..."* Be assured that your clergymen and Caritas volunteers will take good care of the starving and needy people. Anyway, **when in doubt, give!** God knows your good hearts! After all, a buck given to them will not make us poorer. Some parishioners complain, and rightly so, that they probably use that money to buy booze or a cigarette. But compare what we have...and they have not...

**This weekend we will remember, at the prayer of the faithful, the terror unleashed on U.S. soil 20 years ago.** We remember all the innocent deaths of our citizens by this terrorist attack and the war against Al-Qaeda, and the terrible threat of nuclear terror on the entire world by fanatic Muslim terrorists. We are united with our Jewish and Muslim friends, with whom we share the parenthood of Abraham, and we renew our respect, friendship and resolution for peace and freedom among the believers in the Creator, making sure that the merciful Lord, whose mercy we have experienced in the Gospel today, can make us ambassadors of peace and love, and not of hatred or suicide. Jesus asked us to pray for our persecutors and to do good to our enemies. **Let us listen to Jesus.**

## DIOCESE OF VENICE IN FLORIDA

### *OFFICE OF THE BISHOP*

My Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

In recent weeks, the Diocese has received inquiries regarding vaccine exemptions and the role of the Church. Because of these inquiries, it is now felt opportune to address these matters.

The Church has clearly stated that it is morally permissible to receive the Covid-19 Vaccination. Pope Francis has recently released a message strongly encouraging vaccination. The Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith has also indicated that it is acceptable to receive the Covid-19 Vaccinations. Further, the appropriate USCCB Committees have said, "Given the urgency of this crisis... inoculation with the new COVID-19 vaccines in these circumstances can be morally justified." Please recall that the purpose of all vaccinations is not only to protect one's own health, but also to protect the health of those around them.

However, I note that the Church recognizes the importance of an individual's conscience in such decisions. The Congregation for the Doctrine of Faith has said, "At the same time, practical reason makes evident that vaccination is not, as a rule, a moral obligation and that, therefore, it must be voluntary." Indeed, the Church believes that the State should not mandate vaccination without allowances for conscientious objection.

It is an individual and personal decision whether to receive a Covid Vaccine. While the Church supports the right of a person to seek exemption from vaccine mandates and requirements on the basis of conscience; it is an individual decision that should not be dependent upon an attestation by a member of the clergy. Thus, the issuance of a document by a Priest is not recommended.

Priests are encouraged to speak with Parishioners who may have questions or concerns regarding the ethical and moral dimensions of receiving the Covid Vaccine. To aid in this discussion, several resources are provided with this letter.

Thank you for your assistance and understanding in this matter. Let us all pray for an end to the scourge of the Coronavirus Pandemic and remember in prayer all who have been affected by the virus.

Dear Parents and Guardians,

As we prepare to reopen our Religious Education programs, let us remain focused on Christ who is the reason for catechesis, the reason we teach, and the reason why we will gather, prudently and safely.

The Diocese of Venice Department of Education has developed a reopening plan to provide guidance to our Directors and Coordinators of Religious Education and catechists as we move into the new academic year 2021-22. The plan is built on our conviction that students deserve access to in-person learning and is guided by recent experience and greater understanding of COVID-19.

Increased vaccination rates, successful mitigation strategies to limit the spread of the virus, as well as local data and national research, contribute to the formulation of this plan.

The goal is to provide a safe environment with appropriate protocols needed to ensure healthy, in-person learning with masks as optional. Considering the prevalence of the Delta variant, and within the framework of optionality, the Department of Education will monitor the COVID positivity rate by county using data provided by the Florida Department of Health. Optionality will be adjusted, and masks will be required, temporarily, indoors in parish religious education programs in a county with a positivity rate of 10% or greater. When the positivity rate falls below 10%, masks will continue to be optional. The decision about masks will be made using the most current data in each county and communicated by the Diocesan Department of Education.

Some of the effective safety practices that were established in the past will be retained as we strive to provide as normal a school year as possible. The plan may be updated based on the guidance of local and state public health officials. The parish religious education website will serve as the primary source for updated information to parents and guardians, as well as other social media platforms.

Please join me in prayer for the continued wellbeing of all students, as well as our Pastors, Directors and Coordinators of Religious Education and Catechists. During this Year of St. Joseph, let us continue to turn to him in prayer that he might intercede for our children that they may be safe.

Dear Monsignor/Father,

Greetings in the Lord, Jesus Christ. As Florida and the United States continue to confront the Coronavirus and its Delta Variant, it is my prayer that the Lord may preserve you in good health.

After letters on masks and Catholic Schools, the most common issue raised in recent communications to the Catholic Center about the Pandemic is the question of masks and Ministers of Holy Communion. Because of the proximity necessary to exercise this ministry, there is an increased need to consider precautionary steps.

It is asked that all involved in the distribution of Holy Communion (Priests, Deacons, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion) wear masks for the Communion Rite. This is to protect the health of both the Communion Ministers, as well as those who come forward to receive Communion. Thank you for your assistance in this matter.

This opportunity is taken to extend to you the assurances of my continued consideration, as well as my prayers for you and your ministry.
