*From our Pastor, Fr. George...***Dear Parishioners of St. Martha,**

I thought it would be spiritually enriching for all of us to read various reflections on the Sunday biblical readings which we use in the church. So, I have invited our parish priests and deacons to share with us their homilies or sermons. Beginning this weekend, Deacon Bill Ladroga shares with us his take on today's biblical message.

**Sunday Sermon – 16th Sunday of the Year “C”**

We see two different temperaments in the persons of Martha and Mary in the Gospel -- and they give us a hint that we might not allow enough space for different temperaments in our church. There's no right or wrong in this. God didn't make everyone alike. Both are serving God. God has his Martha's and his Mary's too.

Jesus' visit to the home in Bethany, was a great day of joy for everyone. Martha was so eager to celebrate it that she wanted to be the best hostess she could possibly be. She rushed around, cooked and kept constantly busy with the important act of hospitality. He returned to Mary's and Martha's home to find a small oasis of calm away from the demanding crowds. That's what Mary gave him and what Martha couldn't.

"Only one thing is necessary," He said to Martha. Mary understood this and sat at his feet and listened to him. Often we want to be kind to people - but in our way. If we're trying to be kind to someone, the first thing is to try to see into the heart of the person we want to help – listen carefully, forget our own plans, and respond to what he or she really needs.

We must allow for all types of people in this church that we call universal and Catholic. Not all of us can be Mary's and not all can be Martha's. There's room for all of us. God uses our talents in ways that are best suited to bring about his Kingdom – both through service to one another and through our prayer for others.

We all need to take the time to place ourselves at the feet of Jesus and listen to him speak to us. We do that best when we gather around this altar as a community every weekend and he feeds us with his Body and Blood.

**Church roof replacement information**

Bishop Frank J. Dewane, who attended the St. Martha Finance Council meeting on April 6th, 2022 recommended for the replacement of the Church roof. Following, the Chancellor of the Diocese of Venice, Dr. Volodymyr Smeryk attended the St. Martha Finance Council meeting on April 27th, 2022 and confirmed this recommendation, referencing the water leaks. The Diocese proposed Crowther Roofing Company who prepared a quote for the roof replacement. The Finance Council looked into obtaining two other quotes, but due material and labor issues, none of the companies that were approached were able to help us at this time. In order to avoid price increases, the Diocese requested a decision from the Pastor to begin the project and so now we expect the work to begin soon. We will keep you updated with any disruptions that may affect access to the Church and the Mass schedule.




