*From our Pastor, Fr. George...***Dear Parishioners of St. Martha,**

I thought that it will be spiritually enriching for all of us to read various reflections on the Sunday biblical readings which we use in the church. So, I have invited our parish priests and deacons to share with us their homilies or sermons. This weekend Fr. Jan Rykala shares with us his take on today's biblical message. *Fr. George Suszko*

**Sunday Sermon – 20th Sunday of the Year “C”**

*From Fr. Jan:*

**JESUS: THE CAUSE OF FAMILY DIVISIONS**

In recent decades, the term “family values” has almost become a code word for “Christian culture” in American society. Influential Christian organizations have adopted names like “Focus on the Family”, “American Family Association”, the “Family Research Council”; and on the Catholic side of things, we have “Catholic Family Land”, “Tradition, Family and Property”, or “The Catholic Family and Human Rights Institute”, better known as “C-FAM”. The natural family unit – based on a husband and wife who have made an exclusive, permanent, public commitment to share a common life and raise children together – has been under such political and social pressure that at times we almost identify Christianity as a social movement to promote family life.

In this context, this Sunday's Mass readings can be unsettling. Jesus says he has not come to bring peace, “No...but rather division”. He speaks of causing division and struggle within families – strife in the family unit caused by Jesus! How can this be? Doesn't Jesus believe in “family values”?

**WHAT WAS THE MISSION OF JESUS COMING INTO THE WORLD?**

1. To reveal, to those who desire it, the “narrow gate” that leads to salvation.
2. It was not to established social peace in this world as it is preached by some.

**THE FAMILY BONDS ARE NOT ALWAYS THE HIGHEST COMMITMENT FOR ALL ITS MEMBERS**

1. The commitment to God, Jesus Christ and to the family sometimes are mutually supporting, example – the fourth commandment: the son who repents of his selfishness and turns to God will be instructed by the ten commandments to show honor to his parents and will then become a better son; St. Paul commands husbands: “Love your wives, as Christ loved the Church, and to fathers: “Do not provoke your children to anger”. So the married man and father who repents and turns to God will be instructed by these verses and become a better husband and parent.
2. The commitment to God, Jesus Christ is many times in conflict with expectations that the family members have for us.
3. Jesus said to those who want to follow Him and be His disciples: “He who loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; and he who loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me” Matt 10:37.
4. Salvation history is full of familial conflict that had its origins in differing relationship to God:
  - Cain envied Abel's intimacy with God and slew him;
  - Jacob wanted the promises of the covenant whereas Esau despised them;
  - Joseph's brothers sought to kill him out of offence at

his prophetic dreams;

- Moses's own brother and sister tried to remove him from the leadership over Israel out of envy.

**THE TRUE PEACE IN THE WORLD AND IN THE SOCIETIES AND IN THE FAMILIES**

1. Jesus is the way to the true peace, He Himself is THE PEACE and that peace can be only among these who believe in him and follow him as he wants to be believed and followed.
2. It seems that in our world such peace is not possible because the people either do not believe in Christ at all or they believe in him as they want and not as He wants them to believe. They have the different priorities in their lives and certainly Jesus is not the first and they want to build worldly, social peace without God, Jesus Christ and His commandments.
3. Let us try to make what in our strength and cooperating with God's grace so that our families, communities, countries become Christian.
4. We need to be prepared to endure the strife and conflict that may ensue when we follow the path of truth to its destination, which is a Person – Jesus Christ.

**Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary – August 15<sup>th</sup>**

As always it is a Solemnity, but **not a Holiday of Obligation in the USA this year**, as the Liturgical Ordo informs us.

*Did you know?* There are two churches in Jerusalem which give witness about the last moments of the life of Mary, the Mother of Jesus. First is the Church of the Dormition on Mount Zion, which, we are told, is the place where the Virgin Mary fell into eternal sleep. There is a wood and ivory effigy of the Virgin Mary on her deathbed in the crypt of the Church of the Dormition.

And the second church is the Church of the Tomb of the Virgin Mary with the crypt which marks the traditional place of the Virgin Mary's tomb. This church is built not far away from the garden Gethsemane and from the chapel of the Ascension of the Lord on the Mount of Olives. There Mary was buried after her death and from there she was taken to heaven. The tomb is empty, like the Holy Sepulcher of the Lord which is empty. In the case of Jesus, it was his resurrection which emptied his tomb. In the case of Mary, it was the Assumption with her body and soul into heaven.

You, Lord, are forgiving and good, abounding in love to all who call to you.

Hear my prayer, LORD; listen to my cry for mercy.

When I am in distress, I call to you, because you answer me.

Arrogant foes are attacking me, O God; ruthless people are trying to kill me - they have no regard for you. But you, Lord, are a compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness.

Turn to me and have mercy on me; show your strength on behalf of your servant; save me, because I serve you just as my mother did.

Give me a sign of your goodness, that my enemies may see it and be put to shame, for you, LORD, have helped me and comforted me. (*Psalms 86*)

**Send forth your Spirit O Lord and renew the face of the earth.**


