### From our Pastor, Fr. George...

# THE LORD HAS RISEN INDEED (Lk 24:34) - Have a Blessed Easter everyone!

All our Easter Sunday Masses are offered for God's blessing to all our parishioners. We will be praying to God asking for his special blessing to you and your families on this Day of the Resurrection.

Like the Paschal blessing of the water makes it a Holy Water, so the word of Jesus blesses and raises our human nature to life. May God grant you courage and confidence in your faith, so like Jesus who accepted cross and death with courage and conviction and rose back to life from his death, you will also receive multiple graces of God and your life will be renewed.

### Sunday Sermon - Easter

From Dn. Bill

What if a young person asked you to tell them the greatest story in the world? What story would you tell them? What would it be about? Let me tell you mine.

Once there was nothing. No dirt, no trees, no plants, no animals, no sky, no clouds, no people.

Then someone whom we later named God decided it was the time to make everything that is here: the ground we walk on, the trees and plants we see growing, the blue sky and big puffy white clouds, the crunchy white sand at Siesta Beach, and all the people we know. He wanted us to love him because he loved everything that he had made and he wanted them to be good.

Some time after he made everything, he saw that some people weren't behaving like they should, so he decided to send a flood and get rid of all the bad people. But he saved a few good people and animals on a big boat. After the bad people were gone, the good people who loved him and followed his ways were saved.

But again, some time later, people weren't listening to him, weren't loving him, and weren't treating each other very nicely. So, he decided to come to us as a little baby so we could really know him. He grew up, just like we grow up, and lived with us.

After he became a man, he told us just how much God, his Father and ours, loves us, but a lot of people didn't want to hear it because they wanted to do things their own way and not God's. So they killed him by nailing him to a cross.

But he was God so he came back from the dead and went to heaven so that you and I can be saved from whatever wrong we do. All we have to do is listen to him and love him as he loves us. And that's why we celebrate Easter. Jesus came back from the dead and went to a place where he wants us to be one day.

And that's the greatest story in the world for all of us, no matter how young or old we are.

#### Easter Week – The Octave of Easter

Each day of the Easter Week is a Solemnity, these seven days commemorate the summit of our liturgical life in the Church, that is the Passion and the Resurrection of Christ. The newly blessed Easter Candle will be lit and placed near the Lectern to announce to everyone that the Word of

God revives in us the life of God. The newly blessed holy water symbolizes our Baptism into the death of the Lord and the new life in his resurrection.

### Divine Mercy Sunday – April 16th, 2023

On the Second Sunday of Easter we celebrate the Feast of the Divine Mercy. Apart from our scheduled Sunday Masses, there will be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and the prayer of the Divine Mercy Chaplet in our church at 2.30pm and then there will be a special Mass at 3.00pm to mark this special feast.

### We pray for our candidates for Confirmation.

On the 27th day of this month Bp. Frank J. Dewane will come to St. Martha to confirm our young students. Mass will be held at 6.30pm in our church. Let's offer our special prayers for all who will be receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation that they will be enlightened in faith by the Holy Spirit, the Giver of Life.




