*From our Pastor, Fr. George...***Dear Parishioners of St. Martha,****Sunday Sermon** – 4th Sunday of Easter*From Fr. George*

For this Sunday, which is the World Day of Prayers for Vocations let me give you some ideas from Bishop John Keenan of Paisley in Scotland, who is the President of the National Vocations Commission in Scotland, and who invites all Catholics to take some time to consider the word: S H E P H E R D S – for every letter of this word provide us with some insight into the nature of the Priestly vocation. We believe that our Priests, our shepherds, are:

S - Called to Serve, *“The Son of man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many”* (Mt 28:20)

H - Called to Heal, *“Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.”*

E – Called to Evangelize, *“Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.”*

P – Called to Pray, *“Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed”* (Lk 5:16)

H – Called to bring Hope, *“..the angel said, ‘Don’t be alarmed. You are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He isn’t here! He is risen from the dead.’”* (Mk 16:6)

E – Called to Educate, *“Jesus took pity on them because they were like sheep without a shepherd, and he set himself to teach them at some length”* (Mk 6:34)

R – Called to Reconcile, *“All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to Himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation; that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation.”* (2 Cor. 5:18-19)

D – Called to Dedicate themselves to God alone, *“As Jesus walked beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen. ‘Come, follow me,’ Jesus said, ‘and I will send you out to fish for people.’ At once they left their nets and followed him.”* (Mk 1: 16-18)

S – Called to Search for the lost, the dispossessed and the marginalized, *“What do you think? If a man own a hundred sheep, and one of them wanders away, will he not leave the ninety-nine on the hills and go to look for the one that wandered off?”* (Mt 18:12).

In short: Serve, Heal, Evangelize, Pray, give Hope, Educate, Reconcile, Dedicate yourself to God, Search for the lost.

Thank God we have parishioners in the Catholic Parishes and we have faithful believers who fulfil many of those demands better than me and many other priests. If it was me, expected to fulfil all those ideals, I would have never become a Catholic Priest. Thank God there are many believers in my own family! Without them I would struggle in priestly vocation. Thank God there are many believers who are called to do those things in their own vocation as parents, church workers, or as professionals. These demands are high demands, these are things that only Jesus Christ himself could fulfil properly and in 100%. And only with his help these expectations can be achieved. I think that

maturing in priesthood means to discover how little you can achieve on your own from these expectations and to allow Jesus to do those things through your hands. He is the Shepherd, He built the Church, He established the Sacraments and He owns the Sacraments. You can’t get to the sheepfold but through him and you can’t lead people to the sheepfold but through him. And secondly, be always aware of the community of the Church and people who need you but also support you and pray for you. This proverbial Mrs. Smith from the back of the church prays for you always and she supports you financially, don’t ever forget her.

**Today (April 30, 2023) is the World Day of Prayer for Vocations**

*“The harvest indeed is great, but the laborers are few. Pray therefore the Lord of the harvest to send forth laborers into his harvest.”* (Mt. 9: 37-38)

Let’s offer a decade of the Rosary as our personal prayer for vocations from our parish to the priesthood, to the permanent diaconate and the religious life. May our young men and women hear the call of the Lord to work in his harvest.

**Many people are sacramentally blessed at this Easter time.**

We had one person, who was baptized and fifteen who were confirmed and had their First Communion at Easter Vigil Mass. Last Thursday twenty-nine young students were confirmed by Bp. Dewane in our church and there will be four special Masses in our parish in May to celebrate the First Holy Communion of our Grade 2 children from Religious Education classes and from St. Martha School. They also had their Sacrament of Reconciliation. We thank God for them, we congratulate them and pray for them!

**Monday, May 1 – memorial of St. Joseph the Worker**

**Tuesday, May 2 – Memorial of St. Athanasius, Bishop, Doctor of the Church.** Forty-five years the bishop of Alexandria, champion of Nicea (325); prolific polemicist against Arians (who believed in the Divinity of Christ but as subordinate to the Father). He is known as the “Doctor of the Incarnation”.

**Wednesday, May 3 – Feast of Saints Philip and James, Apostles.** Philip from Bethsaida, tradition holds that he preached in Phrygia (today’s Turkey), dying on the cross at Hierapolis. James, son of Alphaeus and cousin or “brother of the Lord”, surnamed “the Less” or “the Just” for his piety; leader of the Jerusalem Church; an epistle is ascribed to him; believed to have been beaten or stoned to death.

**Tree trimming in the courtyard.**

I would like to respond to some communications from parishioners in regard to the recent tree trimming in the courtyard. *“Don’t worry, they will grow back within three or four months”*, I was told by one of the workers who recently trimmed our trees in the courtyard. When I was asked by our maintenance people, I agreed that we need to control the growth of these trees and cannot allow them to





grow higher than the roofs around them. I know that for a time being the courtyard lost its oasis character and is now under a lot of sunshine but we needed to do it, and with some rain forecasted, the new branches will appear soon.

**Easter prayer for people of Ukraine and all who the most need God's mercy at this time:**

As a gift of humanity, which sometimes seems bewildered and overwhelmed by the power of evil, selfishness, and fear, the Risen Lord offers His love that pardons, reconciles, and reopens hearts to love. It is a love that converts and gives peace.

How much the world needs to understand and accept Divine Mercy!

Lord, who reveals the Father's love by Your death and Resurrection, we believe in You and confidently repeat to You today: Jesus, I trust in You, have mercy upon us and upon the whole world!

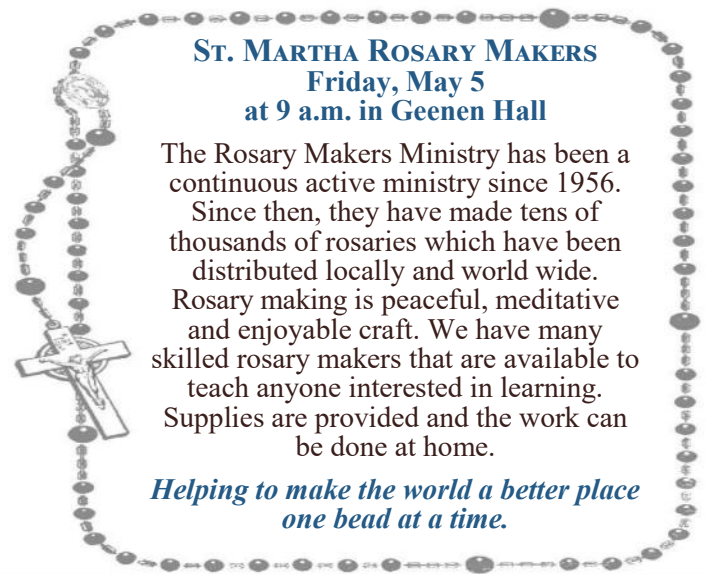
### ST. MARTHA ROSARY MAKERS Friday, May 5 at 9 a.m. in Geenen Hall

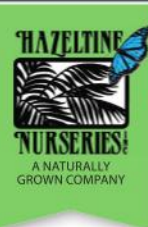
