From Our Pastor, Father George

Dear Parishioners of St. Martha,

Sunday Sermon – *The Solemnity of the Holy Trinity*

From Father George:

In the Bible, St. Matthew in 28:19 writes that Jesus told his disciples: *Go, therefore, make disciples of all nations; baptize them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.* Jesus revealed the Holy Trinity to us and the sacrament of Baptism the platform to manifest the faith in the Holy Trinity.

Catechism, 249: *From the beginning, the revealed truth of the Holy Trinity has been at the very root of the Church's living faith, principally by means of Baptism.*

What does the Baptism call for, what do we need to do to be baptized? Profess our faith in the Holy Trinity. Reject sin, Satan, his empty promises and profess our faith in God the Father, The Son of God who is Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit.

Today's readings from the Bible tell us more about how we profess our faith in God. In Exodus we hear that after God told Moses that: *"he is the 'God of tenderness and compassion', Moses bowed down to the ground at once and worshiped.*

- Like Moses we are to profess our faith in God by **worshipping God, by bowing before God eagerly.**
- St. Paul I 2 Cor.: (Holy Spirit) **Be united; live in peace, and the God of love and peace will be with you.**
- He says that we Profess our faith in God, and we worship God by living united in peace. If we don't, then God of peace will not be with us.

St. John Evangelist: (Son) *God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not be lost but may have eternal life.*

According to St. John, believing in God and worshiping means to accept the truth that God exists on the authority of the God himself who says it. Which means living in truth given to us by Jesus Christ. All who live in lie, which means away from Christ, they kill God in their hearts, and they block their own access to eternity.

The Solemnity of the Holy Trinity is celebrated today, after Easter time, and after the Descend of the Holy Spirit. Only now the Church learned that God revealed himself to us as the Holy Trinity. Jesus taught us so; he went back to his Father in heaven and the Holy Spirit was sent to us as the gift of knowledge and the power of love between the Father and the Son. But God wants to be more in us than just the gift of knowledge. He wants us to actively profess him and worship him.

- Like Moses who bowed down to the ground before God,
- like the people of the New Testament who live together in peace
- and like disciples of Christ who love the truth and live in truth.

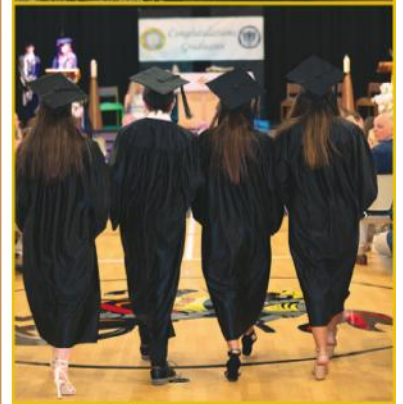
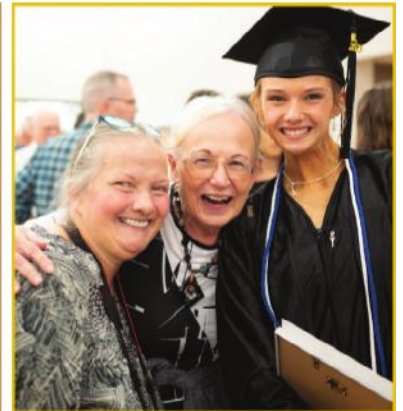
