## From Our Pastor, Father George



Dear Parishioners of St. Martha,

**Sunday Sermon – The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ**

**From Father Jan:**

Saint Theresa Benedicta – Edith Stein shared the story: It happened that when she was still an atheist and philosopher, she was having in the city she lived in a friend, and she was showing her the beautiful places around. They went to see the cathedral church. When they went in there was nobody there except one woman kneeling in the pews before the Blessed Sacrament and praying. Edith started to think it must be The Living God present in the tabernacle otherwise the women would never be so involved in prayer. That was one of the many things that made her belief in God and in Christ later.

During the 40 years when The Israelites was walking towards the land of promise they were fed by God with the manna, the bread from heaven. Fathers of the church compared our Christian lives as journey towards our promised land which is heaven. To have life, strength, energy, we are fed with the True Bread from Heaven – The Body and Blood of Christ.

He Himself said: *I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.*

The Jews quarreled among themselves saying: *How can this man give us his flesh to eat?* Also, some of Jesus' disciples were scandalized about *eating His flesh* and left His company, returning to their previous lives. It was the turning point to Judas Iscariot to stop to believe in Jesus, because he allowed the devil to enter his heart.

The same problems appeared in the 16 century during the reformation. Some of the Christians who called themselves *Protestants* abandoned the believe in the real presence of Jesus in The Holly Eucharist and decided it was just the symbolic but not real.

In the 6 chapter of the Gospel of John Jesus teaching his disciples about eating His Flesh is using not the word eat in Greek *estho* but the more striking term *trago* to munch or chew. He introduces the concept of *drinking his blood*, which has nothing to do with multiplication of loaves – the precipitating event for this discourse – and only makes sense if Jesus is moving toward a Eucharistic application in his discourse. Eating animal blood was forbidden in the Old Testament because the *life . . . is in the blood* God does not want us to share in the life of animals, but the Blood of Christ is the Blood of God, and he does want us to share in divine life.

Our reflection on these Scripture passages for Corpus Christi should cause us great joy, and thanksgiving, first of all, for God's tremendous provision for our needs, both physical and spiritual, the greatest sign of which is his daily gift of The Eucharist, The Flesh of His own Son, for us.

It should also help us to increase our Eucharistic devotion. To come often and kneeling to adore living God, Jesus, present in tabernacle for us.

**Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus – Fri. June 16, 2023**

The Feast dates back to 1673, when a French nun who belonged to the Order of the Visitation of Holy Mary (Visitandines) in eastern France began to receive visions about the Sacred Heart. Jesus appeared to Sister Margaret Mary Alacoque and revealed ways to venerate his Sacred Heart and explained the immense love he has for humanity, appearing with his heart visible outside his chest, on fire, and surrounded by a crown of thorns. These different ways include partaking in a holy hour on Thursdays and the reception of the Eucharist on the first Friday of every month. Jesus told Sister Margaret Mary: *My Sacred Heart is so intense in its love for men, and for you in particular, that not being able to contain within it the flames of its ardent charity, they must be transmitted through all means.*

**Our Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus**

On each Friday of the month of June there will be prayer of the Litany to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus after each Mass, with the statue of the Sacred Heart placed in the sanctuary for this special occasion. Let's ask Christ to show his mercy and grant us his blessing!
