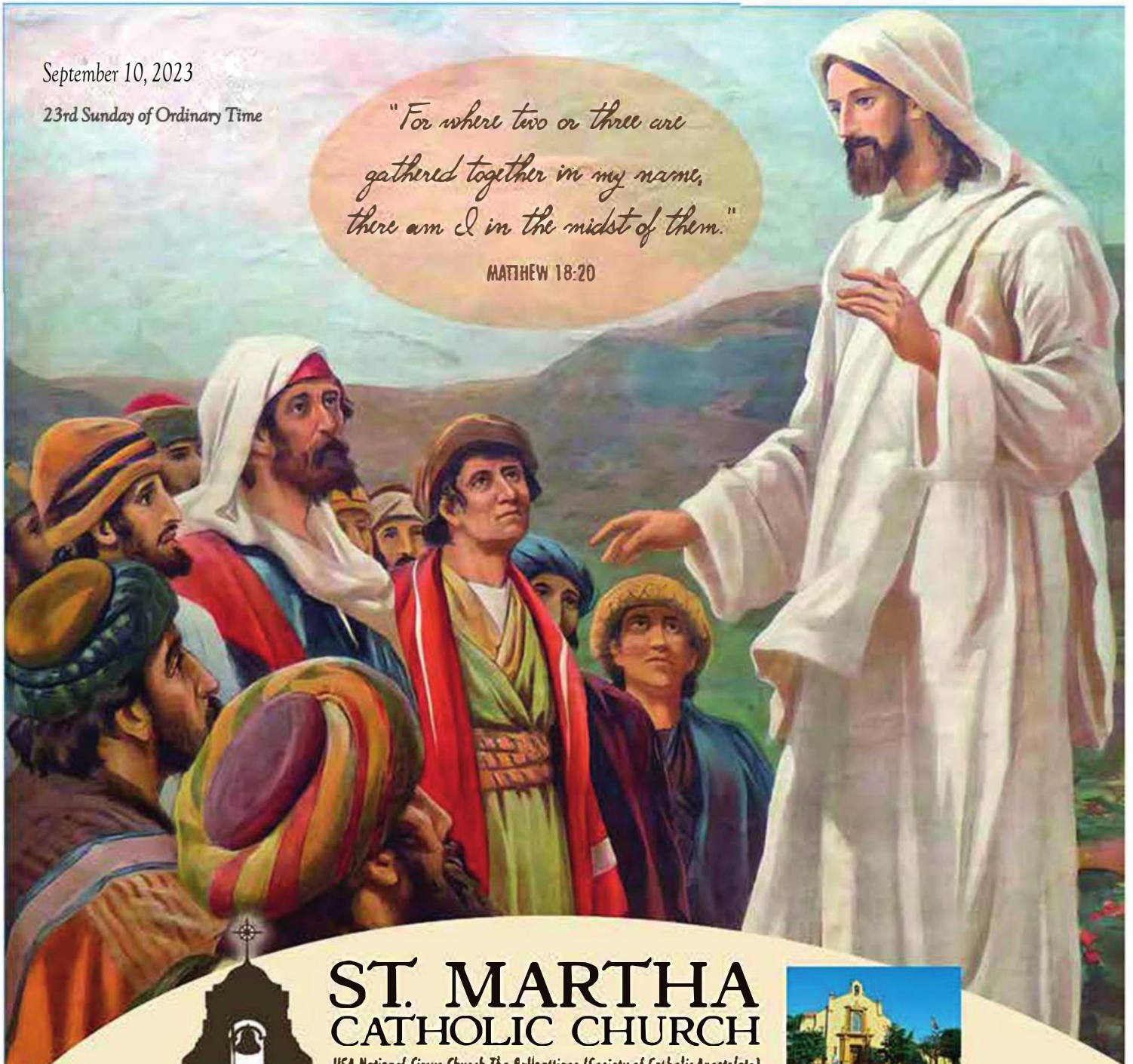

From Our Pastor, Father George

September 10, 2023

Sunday Sermon – 23rd Sunday of Ordinary Time

Dear Parishioners of St. Martha,

Do you remember the film “Mission” with Robert De Niro playing a slave trader in South America. He loved a woman, but he found out that his younger brother was also in love with her, and when he was away on his slave hunting expedition, they were having an affair. He got furious, took his sword and went outside to seek his brother. When he found him outside on the street, he charged against him with his sword and because he was very good with swords, he quickly killed his brother. He thought that he was on the side of justice.

Jesus advises to calm down emotions and not allow anger to poison our relationships. Pride, lack of patience, overreacting destroy communication and peace and they may lead to crime. Jesus says: go to your brother and talk to him personally, face to face, in private. If that doesn’t bring any result, then ask other people to help you in negotiations. If that still doesn’t help, then involve the Church and if nobody is able to bring your brother to repent from his sin than you exclude him from your life. But not before you exhaust all attempts to make your brother ask for forgiveness and definitely without harming his life.

Jesus also tells us in the gospel how the unity and harmony between people are beneficial to them. His assurance of God’s blessing to a united prayer of two or three people stand in clear opposition to discord and anger between brothers. Living in the kingdom of God where repentance, love, forgiveness and reconciliation regulate relationships is much better than quarrels and hatred. We should listen to the Lord and try our best to reconcile among ourselves and then to pray together, worship God together. This is more profitable for everyone; it pleases God and invites his grace.



40 DAYS FOR LIFE

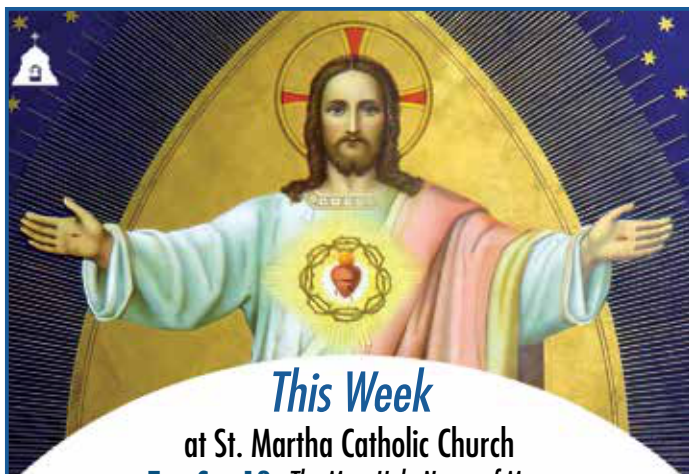
September 27-November 5, 2023


