#### From Our Pastor, Father George October 1, 2023



**Sunday Sermon** – 26th Sunday of Ordinary Time

#### Dear Parishioners of St. Martha,

I would like to give you an example of how you say yes to the Lord and how you do his will in life. One courageous couple, Joseph and Victoria, did it, even under the threat of losing their lives. They lived in southern Poland during the World War II, during which the German Nazis, who occupied Poland for six years from 1939 until 1945, enforced their own cruel law on the people of Poland to denounce any Jewish people to the authorities and not to give them any shelter. If any household were caught at hiding a Jewish person, they were all executed. Joseph and Victoria, who was pregnant, had six children already and they were hiding eight Jewish people in the attic of their home. In 1944 somebody reported them to the German Police and the police came, discovered the eight members of the two Jewish family, they shot them dead right there and then they shot dead the whole Ulma family including children.

On Sunday, Sept. 10, 2023, the beatification Mass was held in Markowa in Poland, where all this horrific martyrdom had taken place, and at this Mass Joseph and Victoria Ulm with their seven children have been pronounced Blessed.

There was a comment of the priest from the Diocese in Poland who led the Beatification process, where the Ulm Family lived and were beatified by the Vatican Legate Cardinal Marcello Semeraro, who said:

They are now Blessed for they died because they gave clear witness to the Christian love which flew from their faith.

The are now Blessed, for they showed their Christian love in accepting to hide the members of two Jewish families.

They are now Blessed, for the German Police shot them dead for hatred to the Catholic faith.

We can pray to God through the intercession of the Ulma Family that God almighty will strengthen our love of God and love of neighbor, grant us courage and perseverance in faith even in adversities.

#### From Father George






