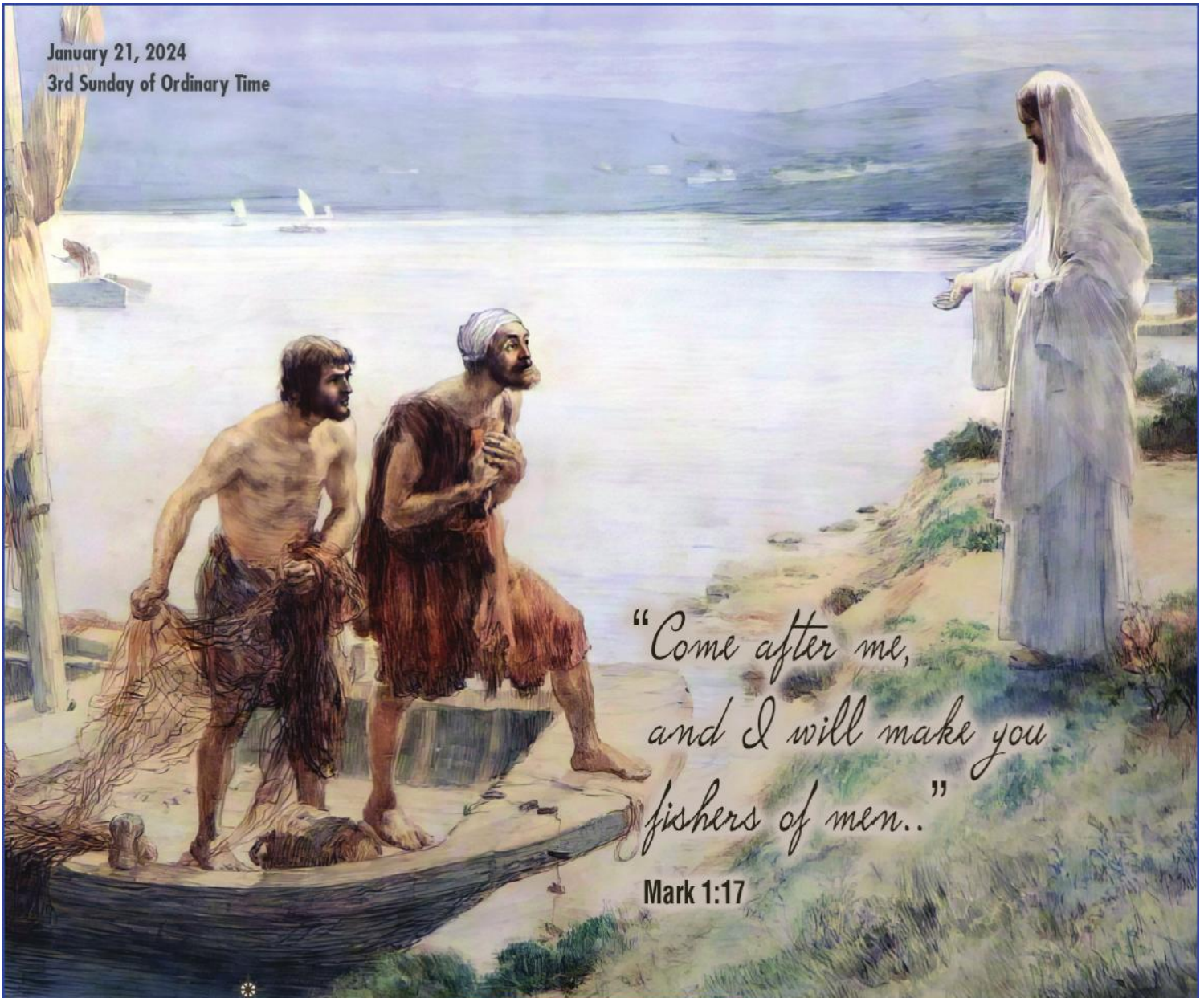

From Our Pastor, Father George

January 21, 2024 - 3rd Sunday in the Year

From Father George
Dear Parishioners of St. Martha,

Understanding of the transubstantiation of bread into the body of Christ!

Christ according to St. Thomas Aquinas. (Bishop Robert Barron: This is my Body).
St. Thomas Aquinas took up the language of the Fourth Lateran Council and attempted to articulate the Eucharistic change in terms of substance and accident.

The specific question that he posed was the following: whether bread can be changed into the body of Christ. Having denied, for obvious reasons, that the change could be through some sort of ordinary local motion (the bread leaving and the body of Christ arriving), Thomas claims that the change takes place at the level of substance, that underlying and essentially invisible substrate that constitutes the deepest identity of a given thing. The substances of the bread and wine change into the substances of the Body and Blood of Jesus, even while the accidents (appearances) of bread and wine remain. This change, unlike anything that occurs in nature, is due to the extraordinary intensity of the divine power, which can reach, as it does in the act of creation, to the very roots of reality. The same God who made bread and wine from nothing and sustains them in existence from moment to moment can transform the deepest ontological centers of those things into something else.

January 22, - Day of prayers for the legal protection of unborn children: Florida Bishops asks us to pray for life as there is an extreme ballot initiative proposing to amend our state constitution to legalize full-term abortion, which is a grave concern.

Last Thursday of the month Adoration – January 25th Faith will tell us *Christ is present, when our human senses fail* (from the hymn: Tantum ergo Sacramentum). Come to our church and adore, in silence, the Lord Jesus in the exposed Blessed Sacrament, on Thursday, January 25, 2024, from 6-7pm.

Week of prayers for Christian Unity Between January 18 and 25, 2023, all Christians are invited to pray for the unity of the Church of Christ in the world. Jesus himself teaches us to be united so let's observe the Lord's commandment: "...that they may be one, as we are one – I living in them, you living in me – that their unity may be complete. So shall the world know that you sent me, and that you loved them as you loved me." (John 17: 22b-23)

Also January 22, Feast of St. Vincent Pallotti, a Roman priest who was born on April 21, 1795, and died in Rome on January 22, 1850, was telling all Christians and all members of the Catholic Church about taking leadership in spreading the gospel values.

He used to say that everyone is an apostle and no matter who we are, we are all called to follow Jesus and offer our charity to our neighbor. He founded the Society of the Catholic Apostolate (The Pallottines) which is the part of the Union of the Catholic Apostolate. Catholic apostolate, which means universal, is for everyone who wants to help and everyone who needs help. Lay people as well as clergy can revive faith and re-ignite love in the Church.

The Small Groups of the Eucharistic Revival Groups of about 6 people will be created from all participants, we will watch the prepared material on video and then in our small groups, with the help of the table facilitator, we will be sharing, discussing, listening and learning more about the Lord Jesus Christ and the Eucharist. The material (Video material, questions and comments) prepared by the Eucharistic Revival Committee on behalf of the US Bishops Conference will last about two hours. There will be seven sessions, once a week.

Bishop Robert Barron writes in his book, *This is my Body* In a very real sense, death (and the fear of death) stands behind all sin, and hence Jesus had to journey into the realm of death and, through the sacrifice, twist it back to life. (p. 57)

Next Sunday (January 28, 2024) is the 4th Sunday of the Year.
