# From Our Pastor, Father George

January 28, 2024 - 4th Sunday in the Year

From Father Jan

Dear Parishioners of St. Martha,
The Sacrament of Confession — The Exorcism
Performed by the Priests to Free Catholics from The Slavery to
Sin and The Devil

Moses was sent by God to free The Israelites from the slavery to the king of Egypt, the Faraon with the mighty signs called the Egyptian plagues and mighty words which he said and did following God's instruction.

At the end of his life, when the Israelites were about to enter the Land God had promised to give to Abraham, Isaak and Jacob and their descendants, Moses reminded his people to listen to the prophet whom God will sent to them from among themselves in the future. He will be like Moses and everybody has to listen to his words, because whoever will not listen to him will be judged by God himself.

When John The Baptist started his mission of preaching and baptizing the religious authorities from Jerusalem asked him: *are you the prophet?* John answered: *The Mightier One is coming after me* referring to Jesus as being The Prophet like Moses who supposed to be sent by God as Moses promised The Israelites.

Jesus` ministry was: Preaching of Good News of the Kingdom of God to establish that Kingdom on the earth and freeing all people from slavery to Satan and sin. His Words and deeds were very powerful astonishing everybody who was present wherever He preached and performed miracles, and they asked: What is it? A new teaching with authority. He commands even the unclean spirits and they obey him.

Jesus entrusted His own power over the evil forces to his church which exercises it through the sacraments and sacramentals but mainly through the sacrament of confession. The sacrament of confession has great power for spiritual warfare, and those in spiritual bondage should make frequent recourse to it.

Fr. Gabriele Amorth, the chief exorcist of Rome under the pontificates of St. John Paul II and Benedict XIV, has said: Many times I have written that Satan is much more enraged when we take souls from him through confession than when we take away bodies through exorcism. When asked if the 'best' exorcism is the Sacrament of Confession, he answered affirmative. It is most direct means to fight Satan, because it is the sacrament that tears souls from the demon's grasp, strengthens against sin, unites us more closely to God, and helps conform our souls increasingly to the divine will. I advise regular confession.

The Church's power over the spirits of evil derives from her bond with her Lord: she is the body of Christ, and she speaks with Christ's authority. And Christ is the new Prophet like Moses, the definitive spokesman of God, to whom all must listen or else stand before God to give account.






