## Dear Parishioners of St. Martha, The New Covenant Which Will Last Forever is About to Begin

- I. Through Prophet Jeremiah God Promises the New Covenany
  - 1. Why? Because the Old Mosaic Covenant was broken.
- a. Mosaic covenant at first was very lightly legislated, mutual and intimate, but it was very soon broken by the Israelites worshiping the Golden Calf.
- b. Many more laws were added after the rebellions in the wilderness and the final form it got as the vassal treaty, a severe arrangement where a great king would impose bonds upon a rebellious servant.
- c. When Israelites broken their covenant with God so often, so God had to react and by showing who was their Master as we hear it in today first reading. There is another possibility to translate this sentence from Hebrew text: "my covenant which they broke, even I was their husband." And the sense is also true: the prophets regarded the covenant at Sinai as a betrothal between God and Israel, but they despised his affections and wend back to the idols of Egypt.
- 2. The New Covenant which God promises by prophet Jeremiah is going to be different from the old one because God will "place his law within them and write it upon their hearts.
- a. At The Pentecost where The Holy Spirit was poured out into the hearts of the apostles. The old law was given externally, written on tablets of stone. At Pentecost, the new law was internal, written on the hearts.
- b. New covenant formula is modeled on ancient Israelite marriage ceremony, which included a line spoken by the husband, I will be your husband and you shall be my wife.
- c. "All shall know God...." The personal, experimental knowledge of God will be given to every member of the New Covenant. This personal knowledge comes through the sacraments, through which we truly encounter God and come to know Him experimentally, even if intellectually it is necessary to study the faith.

#### II. The Cross of Jesus - The Great Paradox of the Gospel

- 1. Jesus is going to be glorified by The Cross. God demonstrated his great love for his creatures by submitting to death. The self-gift even to death will result in eternal life.
- 2. The Cross is also the judgment when the ruler of this world would be driven out. This means that the power of Satan is definitely broken at the Cross.
- 3. When Christ will be lifted up on The Cross, He will draw everyone to Himself. At The Last Supper, He will lift himself up in his hands and give himself under the form of bread to his apostles, establishing the New Covenant by sacrament. At the Cross, his body would be lifted up, as he confirmed the self-gift of the upper room by giving himself even to death.
- 4. John is the Gospel that highlights paradox: Jesus' greatest humiliation is his glorification; what looks like Satan's triumph is judgment on Satan and exorcism; mankind rejection of Jesus on the cross will amount to his drawing all men to himself.

**Lenten Stations of the Cross -** On Fridays in Lent, we will have a prayerful meditation on the Stations of the Cross after the 8:30am Mass.



Next Sunday (March 24, 2024) is Palm Sunday.




### **Defenders of Life**


# Go to the poor and you will find God. — St. Vincent dePaul • That is the Vincentian mission.

#### Information for families with students in Catholic School

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that parents receive the responsibility of evangelizing their children and calls them the first heralds of the faith. The family is also called domestic church — the church of the home. It is so important for parents to be strong role models as active Catholics, becoming the primary catechists in the faith development of their children.

In keeping with this important role of parents, there will be two requirements to qualify for the Practicina Catholic Tuition Discount when submitting the Parish Affiliation Form.

The first requirement is 50% attendance at Sunday Mass for the year. To confirm your attendance, please place your offertory envelope in the basket during the offertory collection (an offertory contribution of at least a quarter should be included in the envelope).

The second requirement is participation in at least one parish ministry. Please find a list of qualifying ministries for parents, children, and families:

Ministries for Parents: Lector, Usher, or Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion —

After completion of the selected ministry training program, the parent will be assigned to serve at a Saturday Vigil Mass or Sunday Mass. Frequency — once a month.

Ministries for Children: Altar Server — After completion of the training program, the altar server is assigned to serve at a Saturday Vigil Mass or Sunday Mass. Frequency — at least once a month.

Ministries for Families: Greeters & Offertory Gift Bearers — Before Mass, families greet and welcome parishioners/visitors at the main entrance of the church, and bring offertory gifts to the altar during Mass. Frequency — once a month.

Family Ministry — Parents and children serve coffee and donuts to parishioners on Sunday morning for a ninety-minute shift between 7am & 1pm. Frequency — once a month.


