From Our Pastor, Father George

March 24, 2024 - Sunday Sermon – Palm Sunday

(with Palm branches we will remember Jesus' solemn entry into Jerusalem to begin his Way of the Cross and we will read together the Passion of the Lord to show our gratitude and our union with the Lord).

Dear Parishioners of St. Martha,

St. Mark's Palm Sunday Gospel evokes an emotional roller coaster; a roller coaster where we are sorrowfully spiraling ever downward as we empathetically align our souls with Christ while he endures the ordeal of His Passion during this Holy Week.

We start by being with him, at ease, at supper with Simon the leper, when a woman graciously anoints his head with fine oil.

The next evening, we are with him, again at ease, when he institutes the Eucharist at his Last Supper. We see St. Peter proclaim that *Even though all should have their faith shaken, mine will not be.* Gently, Jesus tells Peter that he will deny knowing Jesus three times before dawn.

Then, we find ourselves in the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus is praying: *Abba, Father, all things are possible to you. Take this cup away from me, but not what I will but what You will.* Here he gives us the model for us to follow – prayerfully follow the will of God! We are saddened as we realize that he is being called to be the sacrifice for our sins. St. Paul wrote: *For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.*

Even though it is night, Jesus is dragged before the High Priest for a preplanned inquiry. The high priest asked him *are you the Messiah, the son of the Blessed one? Then Jesus answered, 'I am; and you will see the Son of Man seated at the right hand of the Power and coming with the clouds of Heaven.'* That was enough for the high priest who accused Jesus of blasphemy. As they waited for dawn, the temple soldiers abused Jesus. Concurrently, Peter betrayed Jesus. We cannot help but recall the times that we, through our sinfulness, betray Jesus.

At dawn the full Sanhedrin Council met and referred Jesus to Pilate for trial. Pilate *knew it was out of envy that the chief priests had handed him over.* We sorrowfully see the injustice as the crowd, stirred up by the Sanhedrin, *shouted the louder, 'Crucify him.'* Pilate order the scourging and execution. The guards beat him, mocked him, spat upon him, and then led him to his crucifixion. We recall how we hurt Jesus who absorbs the blows of our sinfulness.

We are there when they drive the nails into his wrists and feet and then lift him up to die ever so painfully. We stand with Mary and the other women as we watch him endure his agony. Sadly, when we sin, we do not feel the pain he endures for our sakes! Then he dies. The Temple curtain separating God from man is torn top to bottom as the new Temple - the Temple of Jesus is consecrated by Jesus' death.

We are there, spiritually exhausted, when Jesus is taken down from the Cross and gently laid to rest in his tomb. Oh my Jesus! We are so sorry as we have brought you so much pain through our thoughtless sinfulness! We implore you to mercifully forgive us!

Holy Thursday (March 28) - We will celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper, which commemorates the institution of the Eucharist, with washing of feet and the procession at the end followed by the Adoration of the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament placed on the altar of repose until 10pm.

Good Friday (March 29) - As we fast and abstain from meat on this day of the Passion of the Lord through Saturday, we will participate in the Liturgy (Not Mass) of the Passion. It will contain the reading of the Passion, special General Intercessions, the Veneration of the Cross and the Holy Communion.

Good Friday City Stations of the Cross - Join our Pastor and 26 Ministers of 14 Denominations with over 1,000 others **marching down Main Street for Jesus.** Experience Good Friday, March 29th with the STATIONS OF THE CROSS worship, **starting 7:15am at the Regal Theatre, Main Street & 301 Blvd.** to end at the Church of the Redeemer. Come observe Christ's passion the day the world stops to celebrate it.

Easter Vigil (March 30) - This Holy Mass will begin in the courtyard where the blessing of the fire will take place, we will then process to the church, sing praises to the Risen Jesus as we welcome the Paschal Candle with Exulted. We will hear the story of salvation from the number of biblical readings. There will be blessing of the water, renewal of the Baptismal promises, Baptism of the Catechumens, Confirmation for the Candidates and the Eucharistic celebration during which our Candidates will receive their First Holy Communion.

Easter Sunday (March 31) - Come and join us for any of our solemn Masses on this special day of the Resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ, during which we will be renewing our Baptismal promises and sing many Alleluias as we praise God for the gift of life!

May God bless you all at this time of grace! - We are happy to announce together with the whole Church that the Lord is indeed risen, and his tomb is empty. Life has conquered death and all God's children receive God's blessing of love and a new life. May God renew our lives and fill them with joy and confidence. May God raise back to life the victims of wars who lost their lives, bless all who suffer from war, hunger, thirst and homelessness.

The Small Groups of the Eucharistic Revival continue until Easter and help to revive our love to Jesus who instituted the Eucharist

- You can join in any time either in the Tuesday morning session at 9:00am or in the Tuesday evening session at 6:00pm. During these small Groups sessions of about 6 people, we watch the prepared material on video and with the help of the table facilitator, we share, discuss, listen and learn more about the Lord Jesus Christ and the Eucharist. The material (Video material, questions and comments) prepared by the Eucharistic Revival Committee on behalf of the US Bishops Conference will last about two hours



Information for Families with Students in Catholic School

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that *parents receive the responsibility of evangelizing their children and calls them the first heralds of the faith.* The family is also called domestic church – the church of the home. It is so important for parents to be strong role models as active Catholics, becoming the primary catechists in the faith development of their children.

In keeping with this important role of parents, there will be two requirements to qualify for the Practicing Catholic Tuition Discount when submitting the Parish Affiliation Form.

The first requirement is 50% attendance at Sunday Mass for the year. To confirm your attendance, please place your offertory envelope in the basket during the offertory collection (an offertory contribution of at least a quarter should be included in the envelope).

The second requirement is participation in at least one parish ministry.

Frequency at least once a month.

Ministries for Families

Greeters & Offertory Gift Bearers Before Mass, greet and welcome parishioners/visitors at the main entrance of the church, and during Mass bring offertory gifts to the altar.
Frequency once a month.

Family Ministry

Parents and children serve coffee and donuts to parishioners on Sunday morning for a ninety-minute shift between 7am & 1pm.
