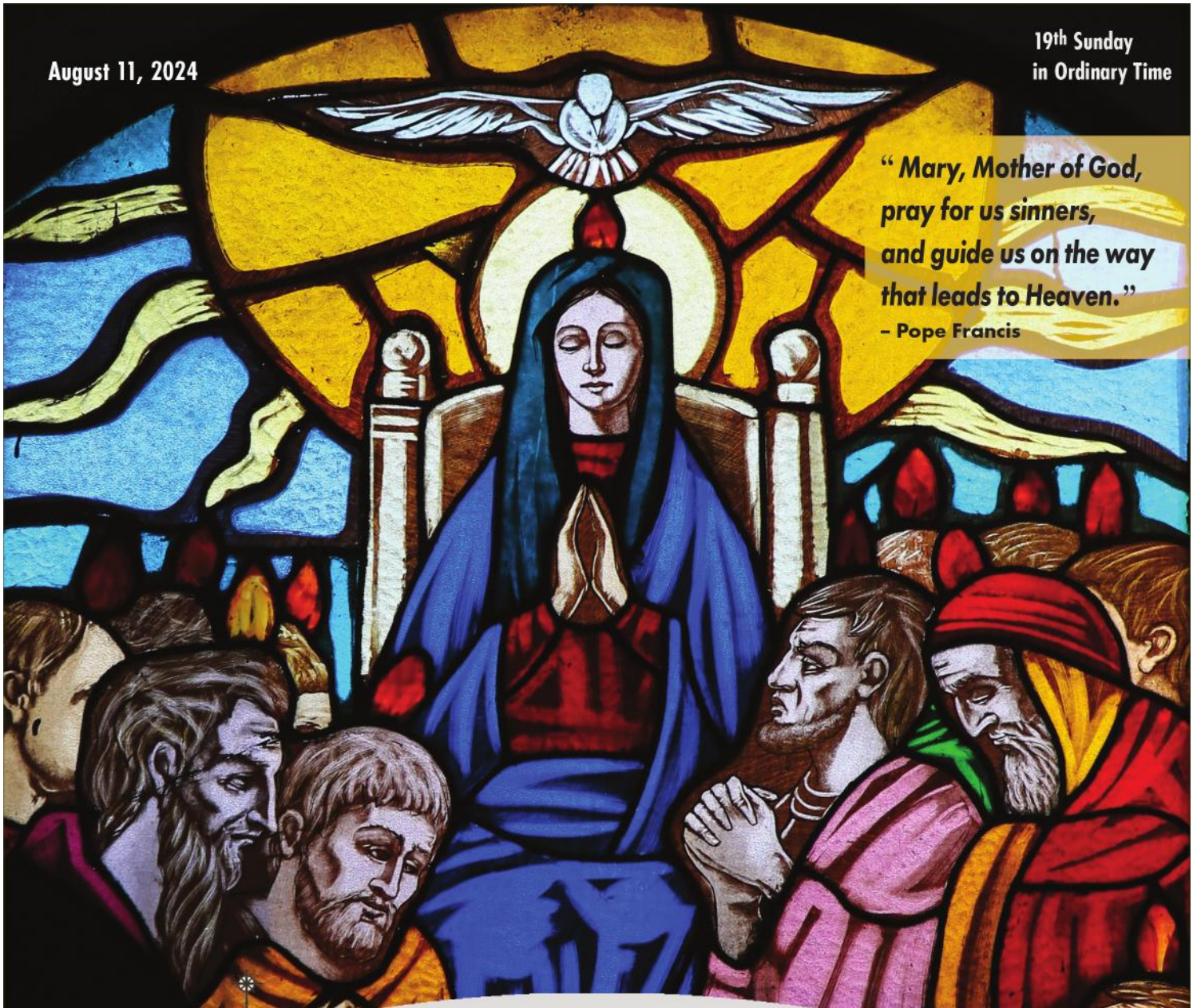

From Our Pastor, Father George

August 11, 2024 is the 19th Sunday in Ordinary time

From Father George:

There is only 742 km between Cairo, the capital of Egypt to Jerusalem, the main city in Israel. It's about a 9-hour drive by car. If you wanted to go all the way to the capital of Israel, which is Tel-Aviv, it would be about 800km and it would take 10 hours to get there from Cairo by car. That's today, with modern means of transportation. It's a bit more than the driving distance from Sarasota to Nashville in Tennessee.

When Moses led the chosen nation out of Egypt in 1250-1230, which was 13th Century B.C. it took them 40 years to reach the Promised Land. Of course, we need to remember that the Israelites had to avoid the Philistines on the sea coast, which meant that they had to wander through the desert. They had to fight wars against the Amalekites. They had to camp many times, they had to survive times of hunger and thirst. They were not allowed to pass through Edom, so they turned again and again. They fought against Moab, against Amorites, against Midianites and the war against Jericho.

St. John recorded in the Gospel the words of Christ who said: *I am the bread of life. Your fathers ate the manna in the desert, and they are dead but this is the bread that comes down from heaven, so that a man may eat it and not die.* The book of Exodus tells us how that manna and the quails were given by God to the Israelites who ate them for forty years until they entered the Promised Land of Canaan. But Jesus concludes that even though the Israelites ate the manna for such a long time, it eventually stopped and he, the bread of life, continues to feed us now.

God has given us his Son to save us. God has fed us with Jesus, the bread of life for over two thousand years. Forty years of his Chosen Nation in the desert, even though it was a very long journey, sounds like a short distance run compared to the pilgrimage of his Church through the history of over two thousand years around the world. God is good to us; he fed his people in the desert, and he feeds us now. We owe Him our praise and thanksgiving and we need to spread God's love to others who are hungry of God.



Cardinal Pierre, the Vatican Nuncio to the USA spoke at the Eucharistic Congress - in Indianapolis on 21 July and said: *the true Eucharistic revival, though always accompanied by sacramental devotion such as adoration, benediction, catechists, and processions, must extend beyond devotional practices.* A true revival means seeing Christ in others, not only our own family, friends, and communities. True revival means seeing Christ even in

those from whom we feel divided, whether by race or class, or those who challenge our own ways of thinking, or who think differently from us. *When we encounter such people, Cardinal Pierre said, Christ is present to be a bridge, uniting all peoples, who are children of the same heavenly Father and called to the same eternal destiny.*

Tropical Storm Debbie - I hope and pray that nobody was hurt during this deluge of rain on Sunday and overnight into Monday morning. Sunday August 4 will be remembered as the wettest in years. We had some roof leaks in the parish hall and a lot of water under the church, which "flowed" like a creek into the church basement. We are pumping it out and we are dehumidifying the church and sacristy. But can we really complain about having too much water? We just need to learn how to protect ourselves from water damage.

Prayer for Safety in Hurricane Season - *O God, Master of this passing world, hear the humble voices of your children. The Sea of Galilee obeyed Your order and returned to its former quietude. You are still the Master of land and sea. We live in the shadow of a danger over which we have no control: the Gulf, like a provoked and angry giant, can awake from its seeming lethargy, overstep its conventional boundaries, invade our land, and spread chaos and disaster. During this hurricane season we turn to You, O loving Father. Spare us from past tragedies whose memories are still so vivid and whose wounds seem to refuse to heal with the passing of time. O Virgin, Star of the Sea, our beloved Mother we ask you to plead with your Son on our behalf, so that spared from the calamities common to this area and animated with a true spirit of gratitude, we will walk in the footsteps of your Divine Son to reach the heavenly Jerusalem, where a stormless eternity awaits us. Amen*

FLORIDA'S PRO-ABORTION AMENDMENT EXPLAINED

Why Floridians Should Vote NO on Amendment 4

WHAT IT SAYS

BALLOT SUMMARY

No law shall prohibit, penalize, delay, or restrict abortion

before viability

or when necessary to protect the patient's health,

as determined by the patient's healthcare provider.

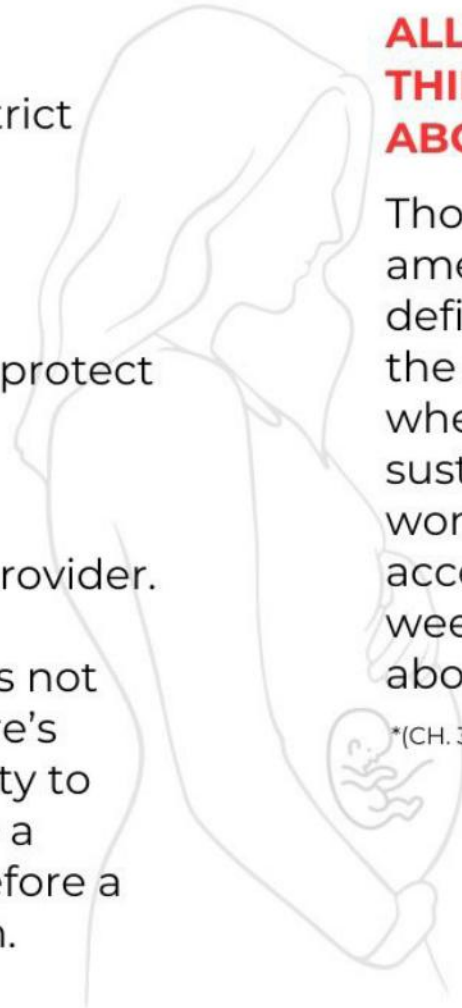
This amendment does not change the Legislature's constitutional authority to require notification to a parent or guardian before a minor has an abortion.

WHAT IT DOES

ALLOWS SECOND & THIRD TRIMESTER ABORTIONS

Though not defined in the amendment, "viability" is defined in Florida law as the stage of development when the life of a fetus is sustainable outside the womb*, generally accepted to be 22-24 weeks of pregnancy, or about 6 months.
