From Our Pastor, Father George

October 27, 2024 is the 30th Sunday in Ordinary time

Sunday Sermon From Father Guennadi:

Today's fragment of the Gospel, especially the scene when Jesus healed the blind Bartimaeus, became very close to me when I was a seminarian. There is a custom in the Pallottine seminary to prepare an annual theatrical performance during Lent. We were preparing The Passion of the Christ. Thousands of people came from all over Poland to watch this performance during Lent. I had just been given a role to play the healing of the blind Bartimaeus. This was quite difficult for me, because this scene is very emotional. I had to understand the situation of a man blind from birth, showing his desire of faith and the joy of healing. My task was to play on stage this incredible experience of Bartimaeus' faith, his meeting with Jesus, the transformation of his life. I managed to do this quite well; a fragment of this scene was even shown in Polish television. While preparing for this role, I was constantly looking for acting techniques to show it, to be understood, and this was very difficult for me. I could not imagine how to illustrate the happiness of regaining sight and to show the experiences of a person who sees the beauty of the world for the first time and, moreover, the very touching meeting with One who performs this healing – Jesus.

Dear parishioners. This scene from today's Gospel, from one side, is difficult to show if we were to act it on stage, yet it should really be very close to us. My task on stage was not only to look for some theatrical skills, but to look into the depths of my soul and find a similar joy I experienced in my own life when I was healed by Jesus. In fact, I could show my joy of healing in every confession, the joy of looking at the world with healed eyes, the joy of experiencing love for one's neighbor.

This story of healing is very helpful for us. Let us look at it a little bit more closely. Bartimaeus throws off his large cloak, which blocks him from running to Jesus. This dynamic image shows us how to get rid of what is overwhelming us, to wake up from a settled life, to break away from what keeps us far from the Lord. The Gospel ends with the words

that should particularly inspire us to think: *And he followed Him on the way.* Bartimaeus regains his sight and something much greater; he receives grace to see Jesus so well that at this moment he wants to become his disciple. We, who know about Jesus much more than Bartimaeus, do we have eyes to look at him? Yes, to feel the growing desire within us that gave birth to the saints: *I want to follow you.*

We can ask ourselves: *Have we not wasted the opportunity to call out to Jesus: 'Son of David', have mercy on me.* How often in our life do we not notice Jesus passing by us, do we not notice His presence? Jesus passed through Jericho several times and perhaps He noticed Bartimaeus, who was busy collecting the crumbs of bread that he received for his

living. How many times has Jesus passed by us, how many times has He given signs of His presence? Have we not wasted the opportunity to turn to Him with words full of trust and the painful truth about ourselves, that we are blind, that we need healing, that we are busy collecting the crumbs that the world gives us, and we do not see the healing power of Jesus. Maybe He was close to us - in a parish retreat that we did not participate in, in the sudden death of our friend, in the illness of someone close to us from the family, in a car accident from which we were miraculously saved, or in the experience of the destructive power of a hurricane, after which we are still alive and our perspective of life has been extended. These and other examples show us when a Loving Jesus passed by us - ready to heal our spiritual blindness, but we did not see Him.

Nowadays in our Christian history there are plenty of people who have deliberately shut the eyes of their minds to the many calls to repentance which Jesus sent. This is a danger and a fatal mistake we can all avoid if we learn today's Gospel. For some among us today this may be Christ's last call. Let us all cry out and say: *Jesus, son of David, give us the grace to see ourselves as we are - and then to see ourselves as we ought to be. Master, I want to see...*

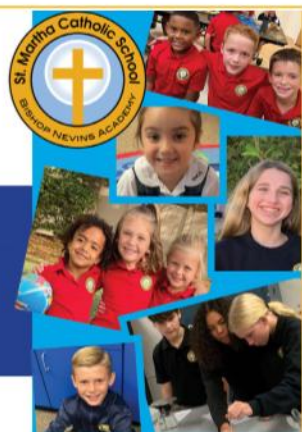

A Message from
BISHOP DEWANE



My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

News of Amendment 4, a dangerous pro-abortion amendment which will appear on the Florida ballot this fall, has no doubt reached you by now. The amendment is misleading in its language, and dangerous not only for full-term babies, but women, and girls. It is my hope that once you look into the facts of this proposed change to Florida's state constitution, you will unequivocally vote *no* in November.

Keep in mind, if you will, that the word *no* is not always negative. In this case, it is not only a *positive*, it is positively crucial, and even lifesaving! Plan to do something positive by saying *yes* to life by voting "no" in November.

Why vote no on Amendment 4?

Titled *Amendment to Limit Government Interference with Abortion*, this amendment would embed unregulated abortion in the state constitution, establishing an unlimited right to abortion throughout the pregnancy, making Florida one of the most pro-abortion states in the nation.

Amendment 4 **would allow for second and third trimester abortions**, a stark contrast to Florida's current Heartbeat Protection Law which allows abortion up until a heartbeat can be detected, at about six weeks gestation. Although in a perfect world any abortion would be unthinkable, it is certainly preferable to have some limits on when it is legal.

This amendment allows for abortion for any reason, including consideration of the *patient's health*, which is undefined in the amendment. Current Florida law includes an exception for when the pregnant woman's life is in danger, among many other exceptions.

Further, Amendment 4 puts not only babies, but women and girls at risk. The amendment weakens the current medical doctor requirement, allowing *healthcare providers*, not just physicians, to determine if an abortion is necessary to protect the mother's health. This is dangerous for women.

The Amendment also eliminates the currently required parental consent for a minor to have an abortion, preserving only parental *notification*. This is reckless, and destructive, for girls, and their families.

In short, Amendment 4 goes dangerously beyond even what was permitted in the Roe v. Wade ruling. **It is extreme, and unnecessary. There is simply no need to expand what is an already expansive abortion law in Florida.**

Some have said that the Church has no place in politics. It is true that the Church would never suggest you vote for a particular candidate. However, in this election year, it is critically important to remember that shaping the moral character of society is a responsibility of people of faith, and a basic part of the mission we have received from Jesus Christ. In this case, when confronted with such a clear threat to human life and dignity, **the Church must not be silent and simply cannot remain on the sidelines.**

Let us unite in prayer to defeat this expansive, pro-abortion amendment, and vote *no* on Amendment 4 in November.

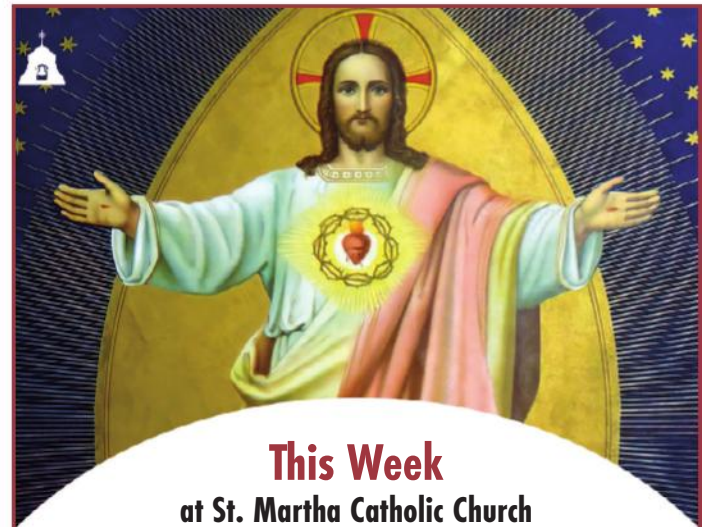
