From Our Pastor, Father George

November 17, 2024 is the 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Sunday Sermon Deacon Bob: Everyone in their lives will have a moment when the *sun is darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will be falling from the sky, and the powers in the heavens will be shaken.* We all face those times, we do not want to, but we do. For my son Patrick, he had one last week. While at law school he was playing intermural basketball and was guarding what by all accounts was a great young man named Logan. This Logan was a physical specimen, he stood six foot five inches tall, was what appeared to be in great shape, very handsome, very smart, and most importantly an extremely nice and friendly individual. While they played on different teams, Patrick in his short time at school had become extremely fond of Logan.

As Patrick was guarding Logan and running down the court with him, Logan collapsed while Patrick was a mere two feet from him and was raced to the hospital with an apparent stroke. Within a few days his parents had to make the decision to remove their pride and joy from life support. They had lost their beloved son and all those who knew Logan lost a friend and role model. One minute Logan was fine racing the down the court, the next he was not. It really shook Patrick up a lot, and rightfully so. But as Jesus tells us in today's Gospel, *but of that day or hour, no one knows, neither the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.*

Today's Gospel's main intent is to remind us that we need to be vigilant with our own spiritual lives as we do not know when the Father will be calling us home. But today I would like to look at this from a different perspective. When we face these losses in our lives from our friends, loved ones, or hear stories like that of Logan, it is almost impossible to understand, and difficult to get through. It is in these times we really need to lean on Jesus, to help us through these times when the *sun is darkened, and the moon will not give light.* At these times is when we need to listen to Him. My heart ached for Patrick along with Logan's family, friends, and girlfriend. All I could tell Patrick, was God loves him, Logan, and Logan's family and friends and contemplate the cross: Not as a bad thing that happened to Jesus, but a beautiful thing that Jesus gave us in His Unfailing Love.

In one minute, Logan was dominating the basketball court, the next he was being called home. How do we deal with these trying times. The answer while cliché, is still true. It is remembering what Jesus has also told us. Jesus has told us that He is with us always till the end of the age. He is with us always; He wants to carry our burdens. He does not want our hearts to be troubled, as Logan's and our own place have been prepared in Heaven for us. He not only understands our pain, but the Word made Flesh experienced our pains.

There is a story that happened in Utah in the 1930s prior to the 1940 Bald and Golden Eagle Protection Act. A store owner at that time caught a Bald Eagle and placed it in a cage at the front of his store to attract customers. One day an older gentlemen came in, saw the bird, and asked how much the owner wanted for it. The owner not wanting to part with the bird, countered with an exorbitant price, much more than a bald eagle would be worth. The man agreed, went to the bank, got the money, and bought the

Next Sunday, November 24, 2024, is the *Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.*

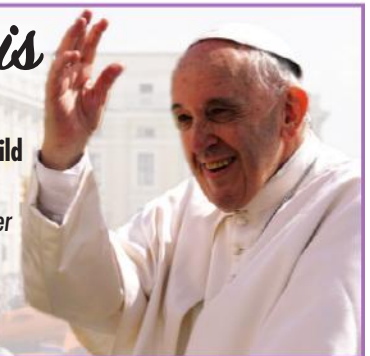

bald eagle. He then went outside the store and released the eagle. A young girl saw the situation and asked the man why he overpaid for the eagle just to let it go. The man's response was, *wealth is not what we got [sic], but what we will give to do good.*

When we look at the Crucifix, we are reminded how much Jesus gave to show us He loves us. He will do anything to comfort us. He is with us always. He is always there to show us how much He loves us. He asks us to turn to Him when our sun or moon are darkened, and our stars fall from the sky. He does not expect us to always understand why these things happen, But He does want us to know he is there to support us when they do, as He Loves us beyond all our understanding!

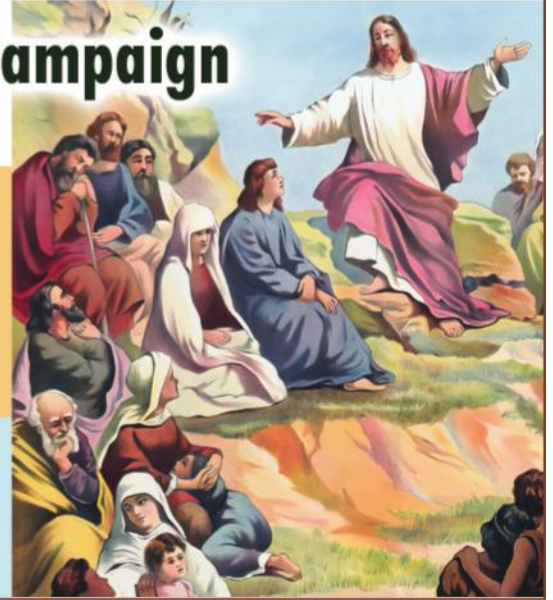

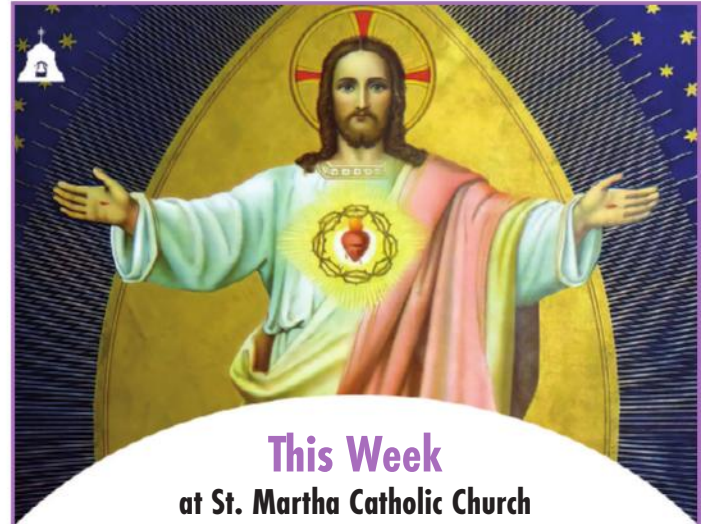
