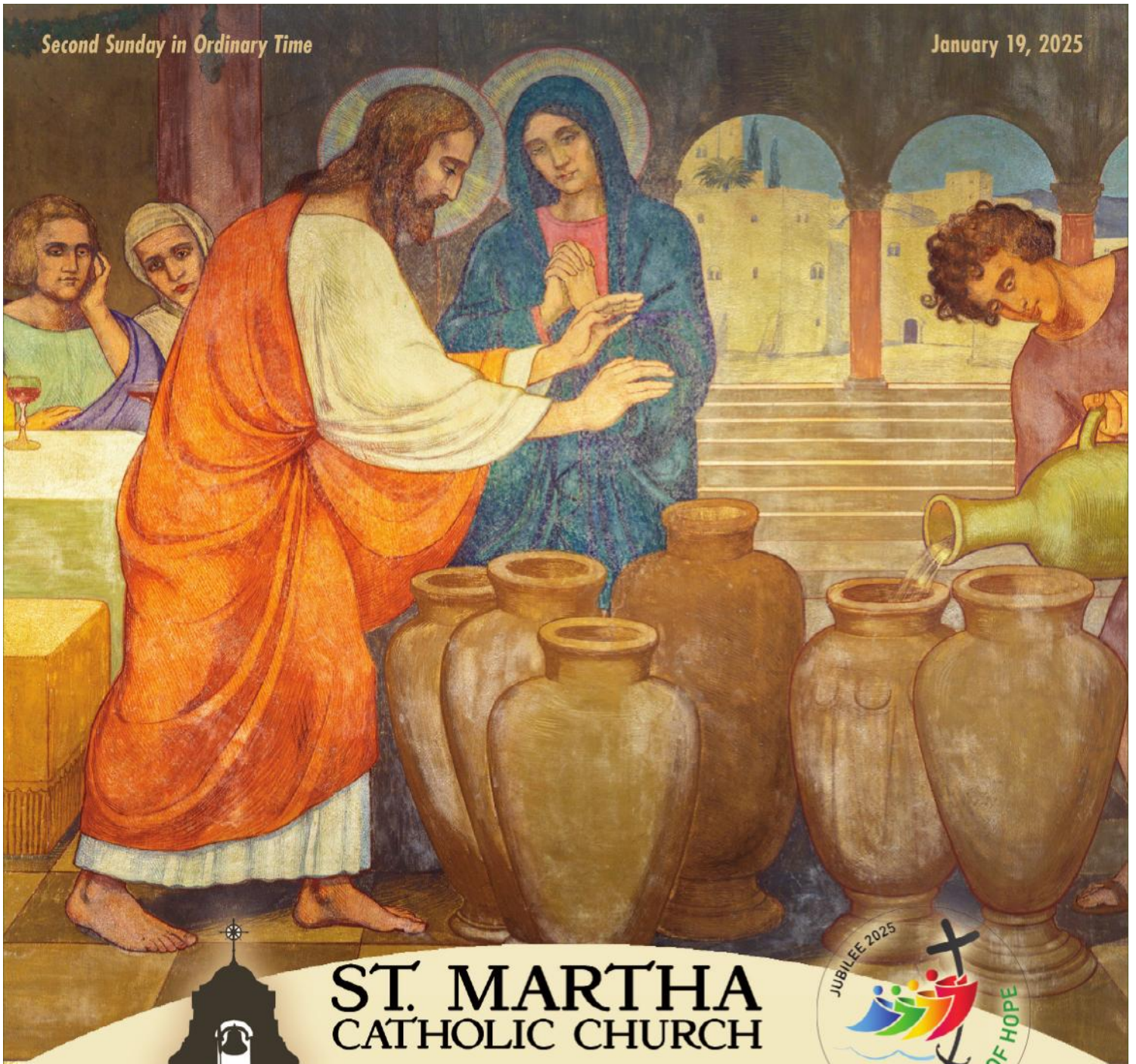

From Our Pastor, Father George

January 19, 2025

Sermon for Second Sunday in Ordinary Time by Deacon Pat

Let's provide some context. Saint John's Gospel is divided into two main parts. The *Book of Signs* making up the first major part while the subsequent *Book of Glory* addresses Jesus' Passion. The *Book of Signs* reveals seven miracles convinced Jesus' followers, then and now, of his being *True Man and True God!*

Today's passage is from the *Book of Signs* and depicts the first miracle - the joyous wedding feast, in Cana, where the host ran out of wine. Not wanting him to be embarrassed, Mary interceded for him with Jesus who reluctantly performed his first miracle by changing the six stone water jars into Wine - not just any wine - a superb wine as attested to by the headwaiter!

We have the Blessed Mother who saw the inadequacy of wine at the wedding feast. She apprised Jesus of the situation, ignored his protest, and then directed the servants to do what Jesus told them. Following Jesus orders, they filled the jars to the brim. Jesus then transformed the water into wine.

What does that mean to us?

In our daily prayers, we are to acknowledge our inadequacies and ask our Blessed Mother to intercede for us with her Divine Son - just like she did in Cana. Paraphrasing the Blessed Mother, we are to glorify Jesus by *doing whatever he tells us*; to grow in our faith; and to reflect His love by joyfully serving others.

This leads me to the first letter to the Corinthians. The Corinthian Christian community was fragmented because some of them were *lording* it over others claiming that they were better than other members of the community. Paul had to straighten them out. All Baptized received the Holy Spirit and the spiritual gifts that they were meant to have. In our Baptisms, each of us had the Holy Spirit introduced into our souls and are called to united with each other.

Consider that in our participation in the Liturgy of the Eucharist, the Priest says the following on our behalf: *Humbly we pray, that partaking of the Body and Blood of Christ, we may be gathered into one by the Holy Spirit.*

Like the Corinthians, each of us is called to contribute to the community without judging others and certainly not from a sense of sinful pride. Paul emphasizes that we all have the one Holy Spirit. No one has a different Holy Spirit. Each of us is a beloved adopted child of God the Father. Understanding and acceptance of this Divine Love gives peace and a joy that is meant to be shared!

That is our Christian job description! We are to grow in our faith, acknowledge our inadequacies, pray to our Blessed Mother for her intercession, grow in our faith, be united to our brothers and sisters, and give God's transformative Divine Love to one another!

Week of prayers for Christian Unity -

Between January 18 and 25, 2025, all Christians are invited to pray for the unity of the Church of Christ in the world. Jesus himself teaches us to be united so let's observe the Lord's commandment: ... **that they may be one, as we are one - I living in them, you living in me - that their unity may be complete. So shall the world know that you sent me, and that you loved them as you loved me.** (John 17: 22b-23).

January 22, Feast of St. Vincent Pallotti - A Roman priest who was born on April 21, 1795, and died in Rome on January 22, 1850, was telling all Christians and all members of the Catholic Church about taking leadership in spreading the gospel values.

He used to say that everyone is an apostle and no matter who we are, we are all called to follow Jesus and offer our charity to our neighbor. He founded the Society of the Catholic Apostolate (The Pallottines) which is the part of the Union of the Catholic Apostolate. Catholic apostolate, which means universal, is for everyone who wants to help and everyone who needs help. Lay people as well as clergy can revive faith and re-ignite love in the Church.

Quote from Jubilee Document, Spes Non Confundit - (*Hope does not disappoint*) "For everyone, may the Jubilee be a moment of genuine, personal encounter with the Lord Jesus, the 'door' (cf. Jn 10:7,9) of our salvation, whom the Church is charged to proclaim always, everywhere and to all as 'our hope' (1 Tim 1:1).

Mary Fran Carroll Scholarship

We offer multiple \$3,500 Scholarships to Sarasota County residents worth up to \$17,500 for tuition, books and fees. These scholarships may be renewed annually, up to 5 years, for students maintaining a 3.2 GPA as they pursue their undergraduate degree. The Traditional Scholarships are open to graduating seniors and recent high school graduates (within 2 years) who wish to pursue an undergraduate degree in any accredited college or university. The Non-traditional Scholarships are open to adult learners returning to school to obtain a college degree or vocational certification after being out of high school for three or more years.



James & Margaret Schwarz Scholarship

We offer the Schwarz scholarship valued at approximately \$7,700 to a graduating senior from Cardinal Mooney Catholic High School in Sarasota pursuing a career in education. This one-year, non-renewable scholarship can be used for tuition, books, fees and housing expenses.

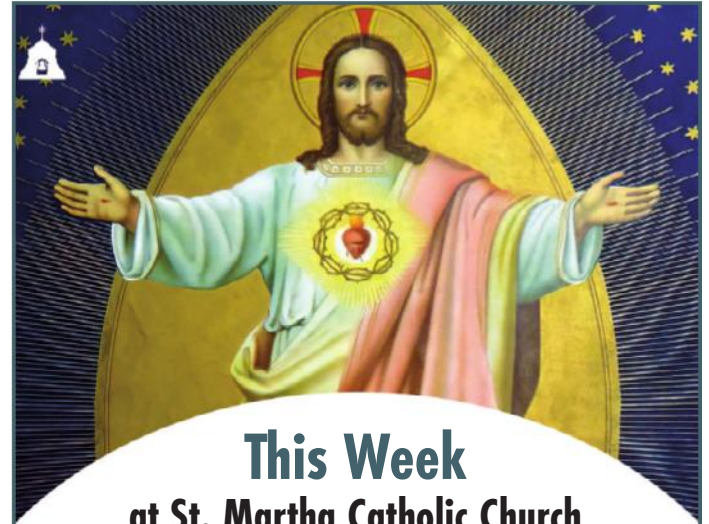
