Sunday, March 30, 2025 - Sermon for the Fourth Sunday of Lent by Fr George

I always wonder why the Pharisees and scribes, who were religious men didn't accept Jesus as their Master. He was a holy man. What did He do to deserve their harsh hostility? The main reason for the Pharisees and scribes to oppose Jesus was the fact that Jesus welcomed tax collectors and sinners. Unlike the Pharisees and scribes, He didn't separate Himself from sinners, He didn't want to show a moral superiority over sinners. St. Luke started his beautiful parable of the Prodigal Son by saying that: *Tax collectors and sinners were all drawing near to listen to Jesus, but the Pharisees and scribes began to complain, saying, 'This man welcomes sinners and eats with them.'*

Pharisee, from Aramaic language, meaning 'separated'. One of an ancient Jewish sect or party noted for strict interpretation and observance of the law and for pretension to superior sanctity.

Scribe – One of a class of doctors or teachers among the Jews, whose office it was to interpret the Jewish law to the people.

So, there was a huge difference between Jesus and those interpreters of the law. According to the law, the younger son, from the parable, should have been punished for his offenses to God and his Father. They would probably use a lot of time to debate about an appropriate penance for him, and they would make sure that he does it entirely and correctly according to the regulations of the law, which they knew so well. Jesus, on the other hand, gave them this parable about the Prodigal Son, a sinner who is welcomed by his forgiving father and received back with joy and mercy. In Jesus' story this younger son is welcomed back, clothed in best robes and given great party. This is how Jesus taught people about the mercy of God.

In 2016, which was the Holy Year of Mercy in the Catholic Church, Pope Francis said these beautiful words: *Jesus is the face of the Merciful Father*. The parable of the Prodigal Son was another confirmation of this.

Pope Francis proposed this 24 Hours Confessions on last Friday because he wants to talk about the Sacrament of Reconciliation. He said that Confession is not about us going to God with lowered head, it's not us who come back to the Lord. It's Him who comes to visit us, to fill us with His grace, to share with us His joy. Confessing gives joy to the Father from the fact that He can lift us up. In the center of what we go through are not our sins but His forgiveness. Let's try to imagine, if our sins were in the center of this Sacrament, almost everything would depend exclusively on us, on our remorse, on our efforts, on our engagement. But it's not like this – in the center is He who frees us and stands us on our feet. Let's see this Sacrament from Divine perspective, then we will like it again – encouraged Pope Francis. He explained that every inner rebirth, every spiritual encounter begins with God's forgiveness.

If we hesitate about our Lenten confession, let's get confidence from Christ who wants to offer us his gift of grace. Let's be encouraged to the sacrament of reconciliation by the welcome and rejoicing of the forgiving father. He is the central figure in it, not our sins, and he will restore our dignity, revive our faith and ignite our love.



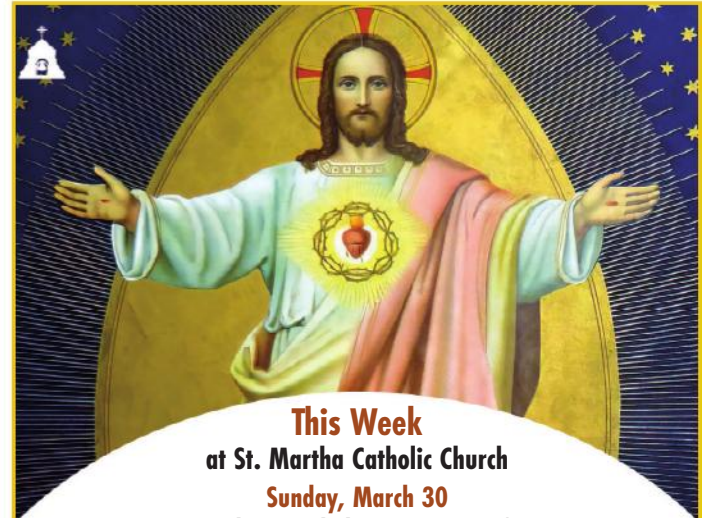
