**Scripture Reflection for Palm Sunday, April 13, 2025**

Today's readings boldly proclaim that Jesus alone is Lord. He came to Jerusalem to die and rise again for the sake of our redemption, so that we might have new life as adopted sons and daughters of God.

As we are baptized into Jesus we are adopted as sons and daughters of God. We are called to immerse ourselves in each of this Gospel's scenes and so feel the emotions of each of their moments.

We begin by witnessing the institution of the Eucharist. The Eucharist continuously renews the covenantal family bond between God and His people, between the Divine Bridegroom and His Bride, the Church. We thankfully acknowledge His presence in the Eucharist and the privilege of receiving Him into our souls.

We follow Jesus to the Mount of Olives where a feeling of foreboding engulfs us as we watch Him pray in agony as He recognizes what lies before Him. We see Judas, one of His disciples, betray Him. Here is where we see how Jesus fulfills Isaiah's prophesy as the *Suffering Servant of God*. Jesus voluntarily accepts humiliation and pain, not out of weakness, but out of steadfast

commitment to the Father's purpose.

We see Peter fulfill Jesus' prophesy by shamefully denying Him three times before dawn. We join Peter in His sorrow as we realize that when we sin, we also deny Jesus.

The next day, we see Jesus being tried by the Sanhedrin who condemned Him. As Jerusalem was

occupied by the Romans, they lacked the authority to render a death penalty. So, they handed Him over to the Governor – Pontius Pilate. Pilate hesitated in ordering Jesus' execution. But the Sanhedrin incited the people in Jerusalem to protest and petition for the release of Barabbas, a rebel, and for the crucifixion of Jesus.

Simon the Cyrenian is drafted to help Jesus carry His cross. We join the crowd following them. We see Jesus crucified with a criminal on His right and on His left. On the cross above Him is an inscription that read *This is the King of the Jews*. He is jeered and reviled. The soldiers, fulfilling the prophesy in the Psalm, cast lots to divide His garments. We see Him absolve one of the criminals and then we hear Jesus proclaim: *Father, into your hands I commend my spirit* and dies.

Jesus is laid to rest in the tomb of Joseph of Arimathea.

We are confused. It just doesn't make sense that Jesus – true God and true man – would die this way. Thankfully, St. Paul helps us make sense of it all. He tells us that Jesus surrendered to God's will by voluntarily emptying Himself and setting aside His divine attributes. In total surrender to God's will, he was crucified. St. Paul goes on to say that God exalted Jesus above all. *Jesus is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.*

**From Father George:**

**On Holy Thursday** - we will remember how Jesus instituted the Sacrament of Eucharist (*This is my Body*) and the Sacrament of Priesthood (*Do this in memory of me*).

**Good Friday** - is the day when Jesus was crucified and buried, and we venerate his cross on this day. Good Friday is the day of fasting and abstaining from meat. We don't celebrate Masses or any other sacraments on this and the next day.

**Holy Saturday** - is the day of prayerful vigil. We reflect on the mystery of death and resurrection.

**Easter Vigil** - begins the Easter celebrations. We celebrate Fire, Paschal Candle, the Word of God, Water of Regeneration-Baptism, we will have catechumens and candidates who will receive the Sacraments of Christian Initiation, and we will sing first Alleluias for the Easter.

**Twenty-seven Ministers of fourteen Denominations** will participate in the Good Friday, Stations of the Cross down the center of Main Street Sarasota. With four denominational Deans/Prelates participating, **over 100 congregations are represented**. This Good Friday, April 18, is the 24th year Sarasota will observe the worldwide Stations of the Cross tradition. What began in mid-15th century Jerusalem is now celebrated in over 200 nations on Good Friday of Holy Week.

Pilgrims begin to gather at 7am. and the pilgrimage starts at 7:20a.m in front of the Regal Hollywood movie theater, 1993 Main Street, just off Washington Boulevard, 301. For those who would like to park at the final Station location (Church of the Redeemer at 222 S. Palm Ave.), the Siesta Trolley will transport you to Regal Hollywood from Redeemer starting at 6am Pilgrims will reach the final Station, Church of the Redeemer, at about 8:30am. At that time, all are invited to attend a brief Morning Prayer Service reflecting on Good Friday inside the church.

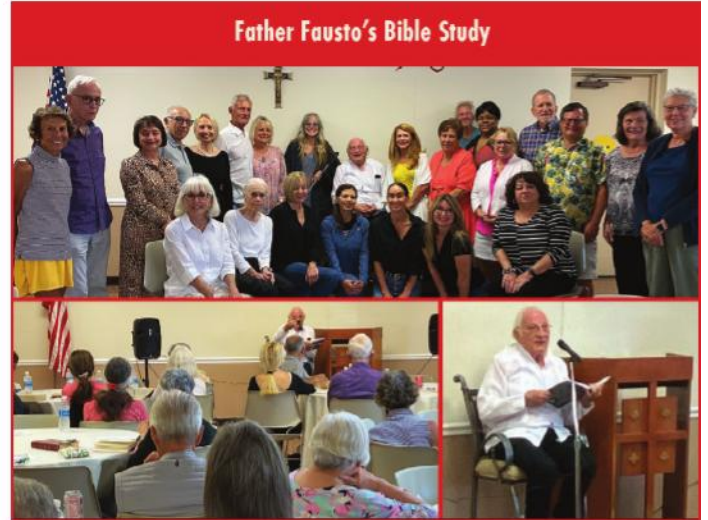

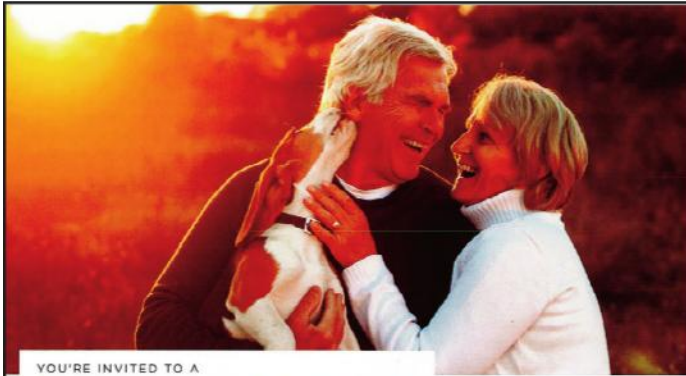
