**May 11, 2025 - Fourth Sunday of Easter - John 10: 27-30**
*Today's Sermon from Deacon Bob*

Do we hear Jesus' voice? He is always speaking to us, but do we really hear Him? If we are not hearing Him, why are we not hearing Him? More than likely if we are not hearing our Lord speak to us, we have fallen into the same trap Peter did in last week's Gospel. For Peter it started on Good Friday the day Jesus was crucified. He had earlier told Jesus he would never deny Him, but outside the courtyard, while Jesus was in the praetorium, he denied Jesus three times. Distraught, Peter upset with his human failure stopped hearing the Lord.

Peter got lost in the flood of his failure, and in doing so lost faith in what Our Lord told him. Even though Jesus had told him not to be afraid, and that He would always be with Peter, he could no longer hear Jesus' words because he was caught up in the flood of his own sin. Even though Jesus had revealed himself to Peter two times, Peter had recoiled into his former way of life. Peter assumed he failed God and there was no salvation for his denying Jesus.

But Jesus continued unrelentingly to talk to Peter. The third time Jesus revealed himself to Peter, Peter finally understood the words of Christ. Jesus forgave Peter by asking him three times if Peter loved Him, thereby forgiving the three denials. It was then that Peter started to truly hear Jesus.

It is the same for us! If we are not hearing Jesus, it is not because Jesus is not talking to us, He is always talking to us. We just have removed ourselves from the conversation with Jesus. We remove ourselves from Him when we have not asked for forgiveness, or we have like Peter, thought we were not worthy of that forgiveness. Jesus has not stepped out of the room, we have! So how do we get back into the room to be able to listen to Him?

The simple answer is reduce the noise in our day and visit Him in a quiet place. The devil is constantly drowning Jesus out with the noise of life. Often times, in my own life as much as I want to hear our Lord, the noise of life prevents me from hearing His loving voice speak to me. Without fail, though, if I bring myself into His presence in the Eucharist, just sitting in front of the Tabernacle, His promise in today's Gospel "that no one can take them out of My hand" rings true!"

In front of the Eucharist there is a peace that we can feel nowhere else. The peace is truly palpable. And in that moment we will hear His voice. We feel His unfailing Love. When we stand before Jesus in adoration, He lets us know we are not alone, we are always loved, He is always talking to us, and He is with us always till the end of the age. And in those moments we understand no one or anything can take us out of His hand.

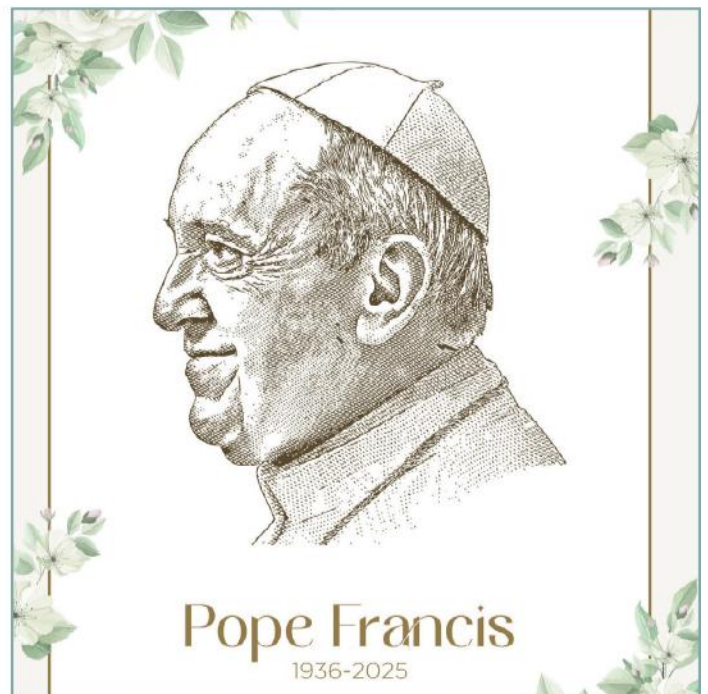
the Church with wisdom and love.

## VOCATIONS

The CFA is used for many ministries throughout the Dioceses. One area is in Vocations.

The Office of Vocations seeks to encourage and support young people as they discern God's call to priesthood and consecrated religious life. Discernment for the priesthood is crucial as it ensures those called by God to serve as priests have a deep understanding of their role, are well-prepared to lead the community and contribute to the health and continuity of the Catholic Church. With annual expenses of more than \$75,000 per seminarian, the CFA provides financial assistance needed to educate and form the future generations of Priests.

Religious Sisters dedicate their lives to serving God through prayer, ministry and various works of charity in locations where those most in need are the focus of their efforts. This includes service in educational roles, nurturing the intellectual, spiritual and moral formation of youth.

The Permanent Diaconate Program facilitates the discernment and formation of men called to the role of Permanent Deacon. A five-year formation program of prayer and study helps to prepare them for service in the Church. Deacons assist at the Sacred Liturgy, confer Baptism and witness Marriage. Many Deacons also help their Parishes in other varied ways.

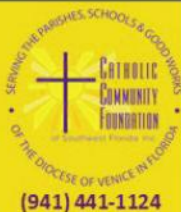
