## June 15, 2025 - Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity John 16:12-15

*Today's Sermon from Deacon Bob*

As many of you know my favorite verse in Scripture is *God is Love*. In today's Gospel Jesus is actually referencing that verse. And, most importantly, He is making a promise to us! (Which we will touch on later). He tells the disciples in what we read today that *everything the Father has is mine*. Jesus goes on to say that the Holy Spirit radiates from the Father and the Son and will share it with us. The *it* to be shared is the *everything* Jesus mentioned.

So what is the *everything*? Before the universe existed, God always was. There is no beginning for God (nor will there be an end). But before the universe existed, there were no houses, cars, wealth, health, good looks, etc. So obviously, these things can't be a part of *everything*, or they would have always existed with God. Since they are not a part of *everything*, then, by the deduction of critically thinking, we must determine that they are nothing. If they are nothing, they simply are not important. But what is important is *everything*. By a process of elimination, if God alone always existed, and God has *everything*, *everything* must be God...and God is Love!!

This also helps us understand the Most Holy Trinity. The same Gospel verses we just read confirm The Most Holy Trinity. Since the Father has *everything*, *everything* the Father has is also Jesus,' and the Spirit takes from the Father and the Son and declares it to us: to do this, They must be one entity. In human terms it helps when we understand God truly is Love. Before anything was, God was. But to be Love, that Love must have a subject. That subject of the Father's Love was the Son and the Spirit. The subject of Jesus' Love was the Father and the Spirit, and of course the Holy Spirit's subject of Love was the Father and the Son. A good analogy would be the perfect family.

We all understand a family to be one, yet often times the family has three parts. It has the mother, the father, and the children. It is three in one. Yet it is one *ONLY* when there is Love! It is Love that bonds the family together. So it is with God, our Most Holy Trinity.

All this has been around about way of say that the *everything* Jesus is referring today is Love. This entire world is focused on striving to get everything. But the everything the world tells us is important is nothing if we accept and believe in the Most Holy Trinity. In today's Gospel, Jesus truly is offering us the real *everything*. He is telling us that He wants us to be a part of His family, regardless of how good or bad our earthly one has been. He is telling us we *DO* belong with Him, in the unity of the Father and the Holy Spirit.

Today Jesus calls us to be a part of His Mystical Body and to be a part of His Church, the one true family in the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. If we truly accept the Most Holy Trinity, Jesus promises that the Holy Spirit will declare unto us *everything*... His Love and that He will be with us until the end of the age.


