June 22, 2025 - Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Today's Sermon from Deacon Pat

John, in the Alleluia verse, teaches us that, in the Eucharist, Jesus is always available to spiritually nourish each of us who believes in Him! Here is what He said:

I am the living bread that came down from heaven, says the Lord; whoever eats this bread will live forever.

As Catholics, we approach the Eucharist with faith and recognize that we, the Baptized, participate in Christ's sacrifice and life.

In the Genesis passage, *Melchizedek, the king of Salem, brought out bread and wine, and, being a priest of God Most High, he blessed Abram.* The Church interprets this offering of bread and wine as a pre-configuration of the Eucharist.

King David's Psalm points to a future messianic deliverer who will mediate between God and humanity. We believe that his prophesy is fulfilled in Jesus who is both the exalted King at God's right hand and the eternal Priest who offers each of us our salvation if we live our faith.

The miracle of the feeding of the 5,000 is the only miracle recorded in all four Gospels. The passage also is a pre-configuration of the Eucharist, established in the Last Supper. It reveals Jesus' messianic identity as the divine provider who satisfies our spiritual hunger. By involving His disciples to organize the crowd and distribute the food, He invites us to participate in His mission through the Eucharist.

Paul, in his letter to the Corinthians, establishes the Lord's Supper as our central act of worship. Consider:

Took the bread, and, after He had given thanks, broke it and said, 'This is My body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of Me.' In the same way also the cup, after supper, saying 'This cup is the new covenant in My blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.'

The passage fosters communal unity and invites us to reflect on Christ's sacrifice for each of us. We are called to examine our relationships with God and with one another. We ask ourselves: Do I truly love God? Do I truly love my neighbor?

Consider paragraph 1325 in the Catechism:

The Eucharist is the efficacious sign and sublime cause of that communion in the divine life and that unity of the People of God.

Reflecting that through the Eucharist, each of us is baptized into Christ's death and resurrection. Each of us is intimately and spiritually in unity with the divinity of our Triune God as well as with our fellow brothers and sisters. I will close with Jesus' words:

I am the living bread that came down from heaven, says the Lord; whoever eats this bread will live forever.



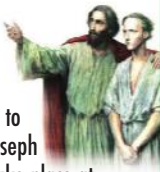
