### The 23rd Sunday of Ordinary Time, Luke 14: 25-33

Today's Gospel offers us a couple of conditions of discipleship. And like many of the previous week's Gospel's at first glance, Our Lord may seem to be quite harsh. If we get that impression, Jesus' message was lost in translation. To fully understand His message in 2025 we must set the table and understand the idioms and communication style of the time of Christ.

When Jesus says hate, He is not talking about the way Ohio State football hates Michigan football and vice versa, or how those in my generation who liked classic rock hated disco and vice versa. Rather, Jesus' term of hate was a Jewish idiom that used hyperbole to indicate preference. It was the culture of the day. An example would be in today's world, my wife hates watching reruns of the TV show *Friends* and watches the Hallmark Channel. Using the Jewish idiom of the day, what the last sentence said was that if she had the choice of Hallmark or *Friends*, she would pick Hallmark over *Friends*. (Much to my chagrin!) So when Jesus says we must hate our family to follow Him, He is not saying stop loving our family. What He is saying is, if what our family

wants is pulling us away from the teaching of Our Lord Jesus Christ,

about it, just that we must be willing to pick it up. As we know from Jesus in the Garden, He was not excited about what was to come. Rather, He was one hundred percent committed, determined, and accepting of His mission: because He loved (and loves) us so much.

we must stay with the teachings of Our Lord.

The best example outside of Our Lord Himself who exemplified these conditions of discipleship was His Mom: our Blessed Mom. During the Passion and at Calvary, she lived those conditions of discipleship like no

other person. Her only son was being sent to be crucified. But she loved Him and us so much she did not interfere. She knew Jesus would obey His mom, because of the Wedding Feast at Cana. Yet she did not try to contradict His purpose for the well being of her immediate needs or family. Not only that but she accompanied Him along His way to comfort Him during His Passion. She was along the road while people jeered, spit, mocked, and tortured Him. And she sat at the foot of His cross as He was crucified. She never once thought of herself, just His mission for us and how she could help Him help us. She put Our Lord's wants and needs over her own and picked up her own cross that Good Friday.

Jesus is asking us to do the same. Our Blessed Mom has also given us the perfect example of what a disciple is and what Jesus taught us today. There is no conceivable way we can reciprocate the love Jesus has for us to Him. But we can always do our best to put Him first. To do unto others as we would have done unto ourselves. To accept the difficulties that come with praising Him, proclaiming His goodness with our actions, honoring Him with our deeds, and celebrating Him with our words to everyone we encounter. As Jesus says elsewhere in the Bible, whatever you do to the least of my brothers, that you do unto me. If we listen to Him and follow the example of His (and Our) Blessed Mom, we will be what our God, who has love beyond all telling for us, wants us to be! We will be His disciples.

**The Farewell Reception -** in honor of Father Jan will be held in the parish hall on Tuesday, September 23, 2025, at 6pm.






