September 28, 2025 26th Sunday Ordinary Time

This parable of a rich man and Lazarus is neither criticism of richness nor praising of poverty. This parable teaches us that there are eternal consequences of what we do in this life on earth. The parable means to give warning as to what are the consequences of our actions after death. God decides about people's ultimate destiny through his fair and merciful judgment giving back to everyone what they deserve. Indeed, God rewards earthly suffering with heavenly happiness, like in the case of Lazarus who suffered hunger on earth, and God punishes an earthly selfish lifestyle with eternal condemnation, like in case of the rich man who ignored the poor man at his door.

This means that instead of being afraid of dying and of being uncertain about eternity, we can already multiply love on earth. Jesus warns us and motivates us to be sensitive and to show charity, which will be rewarded in heaven. Jesus also wants us to believe in God the Father, who is in heaven. Our conduct and actions here on earth have a bearing in the heavenly kingdom. Jesus wants us to remember this and become the people of charity. Loving God loves loving people.

St. Vincent de Paul, a French priest from the 17th Century, whose feast day is on September 27, was a man who multiplied love on earth and changed people's lives. After a ministry among neglected peasants and convicts in the hulks, he dedicated his whole life to the service of the poor. He organized groups of lay people for charitable work. He founded the Congregation of the Mission. With St. Louise de Marillac, he founded the *Daughters* of Charity who are now found all over the world. The name of St. Vincent de Paul is well known from SVP, a charitable society of lay people committed and organized to bring help and relive to the poor among us. Our regular Caritas collections in St. Martha's parish are being used for similar purposes; they serve the people in need. We also cooperate with Resurrection House and with The Salvation Army to show and promote charity in our society. A film, A Christmas Carol based on Charles Dickens novel, gives us a perfect example of how important are things that we do on earth for our life in heaven. When Ebenezer Scrooge, led by one of the ghosts who appeared to him during the night before Christmas and took him into the future to see his own funeral, which was attended only by one or two members of his family standing there at his graveside, he was upset. Then in the next scene he was shown his family gathering, after his death, at his nephew's home, and he saw them joking, laughing and telling themselves funny stories about him and his mean life. He realized then that nobody missed him. He was also shown his poor debtors dancing in the street in front of his house rejoicing at his death,



which freed them from the financial burden, which he kept them in with satisfaction. Then he felt the weight of this long, heavy chain, which was tied around his feet; he was frightened by this eternal punishment which he was to suffer for his earthly pride, meanness and selfishness. Next, he was taken again into the future and shown a small grave of a boy, his employee's son who was ill, and, since his family couldn't afford doctors or even medication he died. Scrooge was moved and devastated to see it, but he also realized that it was all his fault. He paid his employee so little for his work that the man wasn't able to help his own child and the poor child died in the end. That was a decisive moment when Ebenezer Scrooge changed.

He was shown the future consequences of his unchristian life as we are shown today, in the gospel parable, the future consequences of the rich man's selfish life and the reward of Lazarus' poverty. Here is the warning for us, against our pride and selfishness; here is the instruction for solidarity and sensitivity. Here is an invitation to multiply love on earth as Jesus did, love without prejudice.
