October 5, 2025 27th Sunday Ordinary Time - Lk 17:5-10

In our lives, sometimes it doesn't take much to depart from course. There are times when we all doubt. When something goes wrong, we say that God doesn't care about us, that He has forgotten about us, or even that Does God even exist?. In the first reading, the prophet Habakkuk cried out to God, How long, O LORD? I cry for help, but you do not listen! In the Gospel, the Apostles asked Jesus, Increase our faith. What answer did they receive? God said to Habakkuk, The just one, because of his faith, shall live. And what did the Apostles receive? Did Jesus increase the faith of His Apostles? No. He said, If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you. What faith do we have? Do we have enough faith to tell a tree be uprooted and planted in the sea? In other words, do we already have enough faith to overcome all our life's problems? It is about drawing on the gift of faith that we already have. We are sons and daughters of God, but sometimes we don't let that faith have a major impact on our lives. We struggle when we don't have to, we are afraid when we shouldn't be afraid, we get discouraged when we shouldn't. And all because we don't use the little faith we have and trust in God to make everything go well.

Years ago, outstanding people were asked the question: What gives strength to live? Among those who spoke was the eminent Viennese neurologist and psychiatrist Victor Frankl. Answering this question, he cited his experiences from the concentration camp. Well, one of his friends told him that he had had a strange dream. He had heard a voice, claiming to be prophetic, who told him that he could ask any question, and he would get an answer to it. The prisoner then asked when the war would end for him. Of course, he received the answer - March 30. After this dream, the person changed beyond recognition. A new strength and joy entered him. He seemed to pay no attention to the hardships of camp life. However, the deadline was slowly approaching, and there was nothing to indicate that the war was coming to an end. The man became sad, fell into apathy and depression - he broke down. A high fever appeared, and on March 30, the man died. Professor Frankl explained that as long as this man believed in his dream, he had the strength to live even in such difficult conditions of a concentration camp. The moment he realized that this was an unrealistic dream, he became completely vulnerable. A person must have values that he believes in, and they will be an unquestionable foundation for him.

Too many of us look to ourselves instead of God. We look at ourselves and say, We can't do it. We are not strong enough, wise, loving, self-sacrificing, we do not have the money, the power or the faith to succeed in what we do. However, we can allow God to work through our weakness. The Apostles asked Jesus for more faith, and He said, If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you. Let us turn to God, and even if we are going through difficult times, we will regain strength, peace and dignity.
