#### October 26, 2025 - 30th Sunday Ordinary Time

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Today's Gospel (Luke 18: 9-14) presents us with a parable that is both simple and profound. Jesus tells the story of two men who went to the temple to pray: a Pharisee and a tax collector. Through this parable, Jesus invites us to reflect on the attitudes of our hearts when we approach God in prayer and in life.

The Pharisee, standing confidently, lists his virtues and accomplishments before God. He fasts, tithes, and avoids sin. On the surface, these are good practices. But his prayer is not truly directed to God – it is directed inward, toward himself. He compares himself to others, particularly the tax collector, and exalts his own righteousness. His prayer is not a conversation with God but a self-congratulatory monologue.

In contrast, the tax collector stands at a distance, unable even to lift his eyes to heaven. He beats his breast and prays, *God, be merciful to me, a sinner*. His prayer is simple, heartfelt, and humble. He acknowledges his unworthiness and his need for God's mercy. And it is this man, Jesus tells us, who goes home justified.

One of the central lessons of this parable is the virtue of humility. Humility is not about thinking less of ourselves but about seeing ourselves truthfully in the light of God's love and mercy. The Pharisee's pride blinds him to his own need for God. He believes he is righteous by his own efforts. The tax collector, on the other hand, recognizes his dependence on God. His humility opens the door to God's grace.

The word *humility* comes from the Latin humus, meaning *earth* or *ground*. It reminds us of our origins – God formed us from the dust of the earth (Genesis 2: 7). Humility grounds us in the truth that everything we have and are is a gift from God. It is only when we acknowledge our need for God that we can truly grow in holiness.

This parable also teaches us about the nature of true prayer. Prayer is not about presenting a list of our achievements or comparing ourselves to others. It is about opening our hearts to God, acknowledging our need for His mercy, and allowing His grace to transform us. The tax collector's prayer, though brief, is a model for us: *God, be merciful to me, a sinner.* It is a prayer of trust, humility, and surrender.

In our own lives, we may sometimes fall into the trap of the Pharisee – thinking we are better than others or relying on our own efforts to earn God's favor. But Jesus reminds us that it is not our accomplishments that justify us before God; it is His mercy. Let us approach Him with the humility of the tax collector, trusting in His boundless love.

As we reflect on this Gospel, let us ask ourselves:

- Do I approach God with humility, or do I rely on my own righteousness?
- Do I compare myself to others, or do I focus on my own relationship with God?
- Is my prayer a genuine encounter with God, or is it a performance? This week, let us strive to cultivate humility in our hearts. Let us recognize our need for God's mercy and extend that same mercy to others. And let us remember that true greatness in the eyes of God is found not in exalting ourselves but in humbling ourselves before Him. May we, like the tax collector, go home justified, knowing that God's mercy is greater than our sins and His love is deeper than our failings.

**In the Rectory** - We have managed to bring back to the Rectory all the furniture




To Our St. Martha Parish Family,


