### November 9, 2025 - 32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time, The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica, Jn 2:13-22

Today we celebrate the anniversary of the dedication of the Lateran Basilica of St. John, which has a profound spiritual significance for all believers in Christ and is also an important symbol of the unity of the whole Church. Every year we turn our thoughts to this most important temple of Rome, called *mother and head of all churches of Rome and the world*. Let us think again about the meaning of today's feast. At the beginning of my reflections, I would like to quote a poem by the Belarusian poet, Pavel Sakovich - *Do not sell the house your parents owned*. In the Belarusian mentality, the family home is of great importance. I have my parents' home in Belarus, and it is a huge treasure for me; it is part of my identity. Here is an approximate translation of this poem.

I implore all of you, my sons, whatever hardship you may face, do not sell the house your parents owned — that money will not save you. That money will not bring you any good, nor grant a moment's peace to anyone; it will burn your hands like fire should, like some consuming plague begun.

Do not sell your cherished family home - it is no roadside shop for quick exchange; remember your parents' kindness, wherever you may roam; their footprint on the threshold does not change.

The spirit of your ancestors, your kin, has settled in that house forevermore; the tiny flame still glows within, that Mother lit inside the kitchen's core.

Do not sell the house your parents owned, for you will not live on without its grace; it will appear in dreams, forever shown, as long as you are in this world.

This poem shows the family home as a sanctuary of spiritual values; the author elevates the parents' home to the rank of a sacred place. It is a sanctuary where the essence of the family and its history still lives, a spiritual center that must be preserved; this house cannot be sold. The parents' home is the place where our heart is embedded, to which we want to return with the feeling that we will sit down at the table after the trip and be listened to. It is a place where we can tell stories, share impressions and experiences, gain strength to go on a journey again. It is a place about which we can say – we are at home and among our own.

Religious buildings and churches speak in the same way. They speak of human faith and of God Himself, whom Christians worship. The Church is the house of God, which by its very existence reminds us of the presence of the Lord among people. The Church is a place of refuge and spiritual refreshment for people on the path that is their lives. The walls of the churches tell each generation the story of God's people and point to the existence of a reality that transcends the temporal world. This message calls people to reflect on their lives and to respond. And the answer is the attitude of making or strengthening one's relationship with God.

Many of us want the Church to become a place where we feel at home. But, you can't build a house without commitment, being just an



observer standing at the door. That's why it's so important to cross the threshold, take a risk and get inside: there's a place for everyone in this home – without exception.

The vision of the prophet Ezekiel shows the water flowing from under the threshold of the temple, which transforms and heals. Moreover, wherever it goes, there is an inexhaustible abundance of life. It is a story of the grace that God generously gives to those who come to eat in His home, to find rest and healing in it. Here, we draw on God's power to pour it out into the world.

When we celebrate the anniversary of the dedication of the Lateran Basilica, which is the cathedral of the Bishop of Rome, we do not only mention an important historical event, which was the consecration of the first officially built Christian temple. This feast carries a theological message – the Church is a living body, a building erected on a solid foundation that nothing can disturb – it is Jesus Christ. On this foundation the building rises upwards – each of us is an essential part of it from the moment of baptism. There are no unnecessary bricks. That is why it is so important that our heart dwells in the Church as a community of believers, in which we can support each other.





The Homeless Outreach donation box is the way to truly help. Placing your donations in the box will make a real difference.





