January 18, 2026 - Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's Gospel asks us to think about John the Baptist's words: *Behold, the Lamb of God.* These words tell us who Jesus is, but they also invite us to believe and follow Him with joy. Let us listen with open hearts and live this message every day. This Sunday's Gospel shows John the Baptist's strong faith in Jesus. When John says, *Behold, the Lamb of God*, he points others to the Savior. His words lead two of his own disciples—John, who later wrote the Gospel, and Andrew, Simon Peter's brother—to leave him and follow Jesus.

This moment teaches us that real faith is never hidden. Today, many think faith is private, something to keep inside. We often hear, *I believe, but I don't practice.* This shows a misunderstanding of true Christian faith.

When someone meets Christ through faith, their heart is filled with joy and peace—and a desire to share that gift. True faith overflows; it cannot stay locked inside. The happiness of faith moves us to invite others to experience the same light.

Saint Augustine understood this well. After his conversion, he wanted to share the beauty he had found: *Oh, if only they could see that inner, eternal light! Because I had experienced it a little, it hurt me that I could not show it to others... I did not know how to help those dear corpses, to whose number I had once belonged.* (Confessions IX, 4)

One of the simplest and strongest ways to show our faith is by going to Sunday Mass. Even walking to church shows what we believe. Praying together, singing, and receiving Holy Communion are clear signs of faith. This weekly practice gives us strength to live our faith every day, even in places where books or priests cannot reach.

Like John the Baptist, we are called to be guides—pointing to the only true path to happiness. Jesus says, *You are the light of the world.* Faith is not just for our own hearts; it is meant to shine for others. That light shines brightly when we share our faith openly and joyfully.

Saint John Paul II also strongly emphasized that Jesus demanded of His disciples that they be transparent signs of His saving presence. This sign should be visible in their words, in their specific lifestyle, in the testimony of their hearts, in the joy and happiness that would indicate that Christ the Lord is their foundation. True faith, therefore, is that which can cry out with a devoted heart: *for I know Him in Whom I have believed* (2 Timothy 1:12).

I remember a story my grandmother told me when I was a child. My grandmother told me the story of a man who was captured by the devil. The man's hands were bound, and he couldn't free himself. To ward off the devil, he wanted to make the sign of the cross, but his hands were tied. *Do you know what that man did?* my grandmother asked. *He made the sign of the cross in his thoughts, and the devil fled.* That was one of the first expressions of faith I ever heard. I was perhaps 10 years old at the time. This emotional story remains in my memory to this day. From childhood, I realized a fundamental truth:





Fun Fact about the ART in St MARTHA Catholic Church

Have you ever wondered about the colorful stained glass window in the back dedicated to Ringling Brothers?

This large stained glass window commemorates

St Martha's deep connection to the circus community, performers, and the Ringling Brothers. It honors the Ringling Brothers' contributions, which helped fund the church during the Great Depression, making it the *USA Circus Church*.

Created in 1941, it was designed by artist K.J. Mueller Studio (Zephyrhills, Florida).

The stained glass windows throughout the Church are a significant feature known for their fine detail, painted glass, and historical importance. They are part of our unique architectural landmark. In 1994, these windows were restored and protected with exterior glass, enhancing the serene, Gothic-Romanesque-inspired interior of our beloved church. They are extremely detailed, with each piece of glass painted and fixed, as noted in the 1994 State of Florida Historical Stained Glass Survey.






