We know Jesus to be the *Light of the World*. Today's Gospel verses in Matthew kick off Jesus' Galilean Ministry. Without Him, just like the Galileans of the time, we live in the darkness of the world. It is light that allows our eyes to see. It is Jesus that allows our hearts and minds to understand the true gift of life is that the Kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Upon arriving in the Capernaum, Jesus begins to teach that though we are sinners, the Kingdom of God is still within our grasp. We who have dwelled in darkness are still able to have the great light shine on us. The message at Christmas is that Jesus came into the world to teach us the knowledge of salvation is by the forgiveness of sins. Now Jesus is doing just that. He is telling us we can have it all, we can be with Him if we repent. All we have to do is take His hand and walk out of the darkness of putting first the things of this world.

Fun Fact about the ART in St MARTHA Catholic Church Have you seen *Our Lady of Guadalupe Shrine*?

Located on the Northwest corner of the Courtyard, this incredible, original work of art and shrine, commissioned by the Very Reverend Jerome Carosella in 1980, combines the talents of many of Sarasota's historic artists in one beautiful homage to our Hispanic parishioners. The patroness of Mexico, *Our Lady of Guadalupe*'s feast is celebrated on December 12.

Patrick White, the owner of White Stained Glass Studios in Sarasota, was asked to coordinate the effort and chose Sarasota sculptor, artist, and Ringling College professor Jack Cartlidge to create the mosaic portrait out of Venetian glass imported from Italy. Jack Cartlidge's sculptures can be seen on display just steps from St. Martha, in the gardens and terrace walkway of City Hall across Orange Avenue.

The shrine and frame are made from wrought iron, fabricated by Kreissle Forge, a historic landmark in Sarasota since 1946, whose works can be seen at St. Mary Star of the Sea, the Columbia Restaurant, Ca' d'Zan at the Ringling Museum, and Church of the Redeemer.


