**March 29, 2026 - Sermon 6th Sunday of Lent
Palm Sunday**
by Father Guennadi

Today we begin Holy Week. This is the most important week of the whole year. We call it *holy* because this week shows us something amazing: Jesus loves us so much that He gave His life for us. Jesus took our sins on Himself. He paid the price we could not pay. He did this because He loves us—personally.

Think about marriage for a moment. When a husband and wife make their vows, they promise to stay faithful. They know temptations will come someday, but real love stays faithful even when it is hard.

That is what Jesus did for us, but in a much bigger way. He did not have to become human. He did not have to suffer. But He chose to because love makes sacrifices.

St. Paul tells us Jesus *emptied himself*. This means He left heaven, became like us, and faced pain and temptation just as we do. On the cross, people mocked Him and told Him to come down and save Himself. He could have done it—but He did not. He stayed

because His love for us is stronger than any suffering.

St. Faustina wrote that Jesus once told her: *You please Me most when you meditate on My Sorrowful Passion.* (Diary, §1512) And: *Consider it as if it had been undertaken for your sake alone.* (Diary, §1761)

Think about that: if you were the only person in the world, Jesus would still have gone to the cross out of love for you.

In today's Gospel, people wave palm branches and shout *Hosanna*, which means *Save us!* They thought Jesus would save them from the Romans. But Jesus was going to save them—and us—from something far greater: from sin and from death.

Something beautiful also happened that day. Families were choosing their Passover lambs in Jerusalem. At the same time, Jesus—the true Lamb of God—entered the city to offer His life for the salvation of the whole world.

Every time we come to Mass, Jesus' love on Good Friday becomes

March 29, 2026 - is the Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord.

There will be a blessing of the palms at the beginning of each Mass this weekend, and the ushers will be distributing them after the Mass when we leave.

Chrism Mass - This year it will be celebrated in St. Leo the Great church in Bonita Springs on Tuesday, March 31, at 10:30am.

No 8:30am Mass on Tuesday, March 31 - On that day there will only be two Masses: 7:30am and 12pm.

Different Schedule of Mass & Liturgy for Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday - On April 2 the only Mass on that day will be at 7:00pm. On April 3 No Masses, Liturgy of the Passion at 3pm & at 5pm. On April 4 the only Mass will be at 8:30pm.

Good Friday City Stations of the Cross - Consider joining Christians from 14 Denominations for the Good Friday Stations of the Cross Pilgrimage, April 3, 7:10 am - 8:30 am. It starts at the Regal Hollywood Theater, Main Street to process to the Church of The Redeemer. Park at Redeemer, No Cost Trolley to Regal Hollywood from 6 am to 7:10 am, and march back to your car at Redeemer with 1,000 pilgrims all for Christ.

Replacing the Last Supper banner to its original place in the church - I am sorry for reversing my own decision to display this banner in the sanctuary. The good of the parish will be better served when the banner is returned to the side alcove.

Next Sunday, April 5, 2026, is Easter.

present again. When we hear the words *This is my Body... This is my Blood*, Jesus once again gives His life for us. We are spiritually at the foot of the cross with Mary and John.

St. Faustina wrote Jesus' words: *There are few souls who contemplate My Passion with true feeling; I give great graces to souls who meditate devoutly on My Passion.* (Diary, §737)

So, this Holy Week, I invite you to take a few minutes to read a Passion story from one of the Gospels. Let the love of Jesus touch your heart. Remember: His suffering was not an accident. It was love—love for you.

Today we can also say *Hosanna—save us!* And Jesus answers us through His Passion.

We end with the prayer Jesus taught through St. Faustina: *For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.*
