April 5, 2026 - Sermon 6th Sunday of Easter

When we think of the greatest love stories, our minds lead us to movies such as *Love Story*, *When Harry Met Sally*, *Pretty Woman*, or similar movies. Rarely do we consider that this Holy Week, particularly the Easter Triduum, is exactly that: not just the greatest story ever told, but the greatest love story ever told. What is more is that in this Greatest love story ever told, we are center stage and the love is directed at us. Jesus' Passion story is for us and about us.

St. Thomas Aquinas defined love as saying it was: *you and always*. Holy Thursday's Last Super, Good Friday's Crucifixion, and Today's Easter Sunday's Resurrection are EXACTLY that! Our God is showing it is about US and ALWAYS! In our Easter celebration of His Resurrection, it culminates God's unfailing Love for us that is always. Today we are called to rejoice, not for that Jesus rose from the dead, but WHY Jesus gave us the Last Supper, WHY Jesus took the form of a slave and died on a cross for us, and WHY Jesus rose again.

The whole purpose of His Passion is to show us His passionate love (with the Large L) for us. God wants us to know His love for us is beyond all telling. His Passion (with a large P) begins in the upper room. God wants us to know that He is with us always. So how does He do it? He lets us know He is not just spiritually with us but offers us a physical relationship with Him in His Body and Blood through the Eucharist. Often times we *feel* we are by ourselves and have no human physical touch in our lives, but God is always offering us His physical relationship. He offers us a physical relationship through the Eucharist. Like a parent offering us a hug in our despair, Jesus is always offering us the same touch and comfort in His Body and Blood that waits for us at Church. And as this beautiful love story starts in the upper room, Jesus is not waiting for us to knock on His door for him to answer it for us, it is just the opposite! He is knocking on our door (our hearts), asking us to let Him in to comfort us. For Our Lord knows exactly where true comfort comes from. And it is not vacations, houses, cars, popularity, or money. Our joy and comfort come from our loving others and especially Him: You and always.

As the love story progresses from Holy Thursday to Good Friday, the amazing unfailing Love of Our God just continues. In the Gospel of John, Jesus foretells what is to come this *Good* Friday. He notes that there is no greater love than to die for your friends. He, also, in the same Gospel, thanks the Father for giving Him us. He calls us His present from the Father. He cherishes that gift from the Father so much, He accepts death for us. Not just any death, but the most horrific earthly death possible, death on a cross. It is His mission to go to the cross. Pilate tries to stop Him, Peter attempts to stop Him from getting arrested, but Jesus will have none of it! He loves us so much He is determined to climb Calvary because He loves us so much. Even as His human body becomes weak and fails Him, His determination for our sake is also unfailing (just as His love for us is). He falls three times on the way up Calvary. But as God, could He not summon the superhuman strength to climb the mountain with the cross on His back? Or course He could! Then why does He allow Himself to fall? It is both to teach us how committed he is to us and how to navigate the difficulties facing us here on earth. He is telling us that our lives are going to be full of difficulties, but like Him,

if we trip and fall or the burden of our crosses gets too heavy, as that will happen; we need to pick up our crosses like He did and remember what waits ahead at the end of the story. And the end of the story is not dying on our cross, but what happens at our resurrection!

Our love story culminates on Easter Sunday with His Resurrection. Jesus has Risen to show us first and foremost that there is an ALWAYS. There is an ALWAYS with Him. Yes we will face sadness, difficulties, and burdens on earth. We at times will feel lonely. We sometimes will even fail Him. But if we are determined in our love for Him like He is for us, if we need a hug, the Eucharist is waiting there for us. If we fall on our journey to Him, His mercy has no bounds. Nothing is beyond His mercy. All we need to do is confess our sins and He provides confession for that. If we fall, He teaches us to get back up and continue our trip. Like Jesus, what waits for us is not a cross on top of a hill, but an ALWAYS with Him and to be resurrected with Him.

There is a song verse that goes: *everything dies, baby that is a fact, but maybe everything that dies, some day comes back.* This love story shows that Jesus never leaves us as He is so in love with us; and His mission is *us and always*. Today, Easter Sunday is about are we willing to be about Him and always.



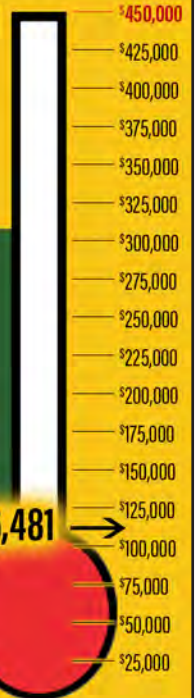

Fun Fact about the ART in St MARTHA Church

The Story of the Agony in the Garden

This beautiful stained glass window represents the Agony in the Garden from the New Testament Gospels. It reflects Jesus' deep emotional distress and struggle the night before His crucifixion and reminds us of His humanity. He went to pray in the Garden of Gethsemane and asked God if He might be spared: "Let this cup pass from Me." But ultimately He accepts, saying, "Not My will, but Yours be done." This highlights Jesus' suffering but also His surrender to God's will.



The use of stained glass as a visual tool is meant to teach through images. The light passing through the windows represents purity, the heavens, and spirituality. Each hand-painted, crafted stained glass window along the church walls is a piece of art, created in 1941 by the K. J. Mueller Studio of Zephyrhills, Florida. Our stained glass windows are historically significant and were included in the 1994 State of Florida Historical Stained Glass Survey. They were also restored by the nephew of the original artist.

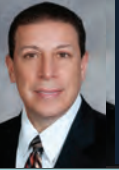

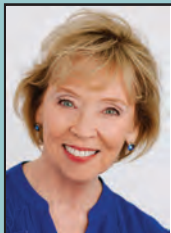
