**April 19, 2026, Third Sunday of Easter - by Deacon Vern**

The Gospel for the Third Sunday of Easter brings us onto the dusty road to Emmaus, where two disciples walk away from Jerusalem burdened by disappointment and confusion. They had hoped Jesus was the one to redeem Israel—but the cross shattered those hopes. Though the tomb is empty, their hearts are still heavy. They are moving, but in the wrong direction.

How familiar their story is. Many of us know what it feels like to walk away discouraged, to carry unanswered questions, or to feel that God has not acted as we expected. Easter faith is not always instant joy. Often, it begins with bewilderment.

Jesus meets the disciples precisely there—on the road of doubt and sadness. He does not rebuke them or reveal himself immediately. Instead, he walks with them. He listens. He allows them to speak about their pain. Only then does he gently open the Scriptures so they can begin to understand God's plan. This is a powerful reminder that Christ is closest not when everything is clear, but when we are searching.

The turning point comes not on the road, but at the table. When Jesus takes bread, blesses it, breaks it, and gives it to them, their eyes are opened. This unmistakably echoes the Eucharist. The risen Lord reveals himself in the breaking of the bread, reminding us that he remains with his Church through the sacrament of his Body and Blood.

Notice what happens next: once they recognize Jesus, he vanishes from their sight. They no longer need to see him physically – because now they know where to find him. Fired by faith, the disciples immediately return to Jerusalem, even though night has fallen. Encountering the risen Christ transforms them from discouraged followers into joyful witnesses.

Easter calls us to the same transformation. The risen Jesus walks

with us through Scripture, meets us at the Eucharistic table, and invites us to recognize his presence in our everyday lives. When we allow him to open our minds and hearts, we too can feel our hearts *burn within us*.

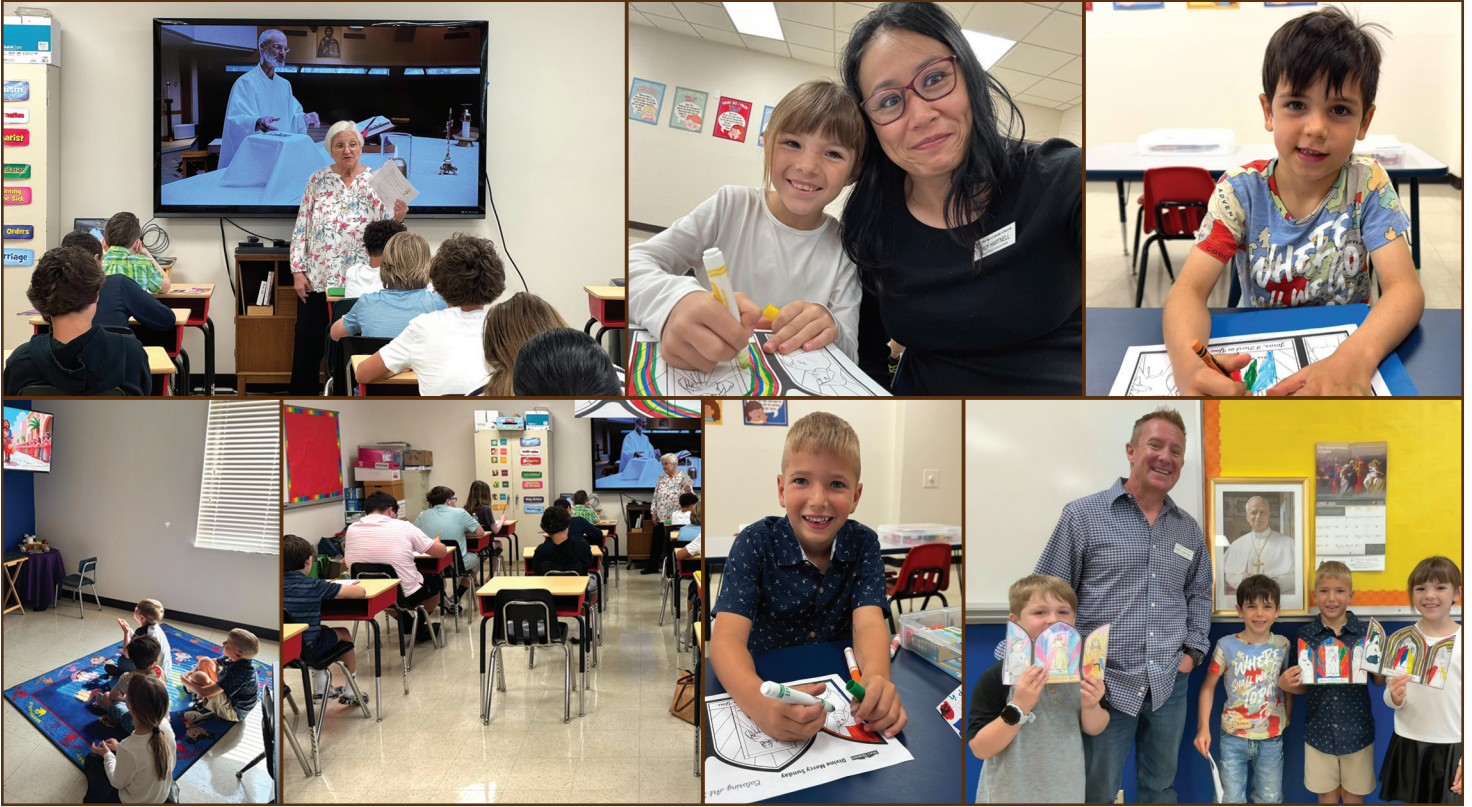
This week, we might ask ourselves:

- Do I recognize Jesus walking with me, even in moments of confusion?
- Do I allow the Word of God and the Eucharist to shape my understanding?
- Am I willing to return to my community with renewed faith and joy?

The road to Emmaus did not end in disappointment. It became the path back to hope. May our Easter journey do the same leading us from doubt to faith, from sorrow to joy, and from isolation to mission.
