May 3, 2026, Fifth Sunday of Easter - John 14:1-12

Sometimes even good, prayerful people carry a quiet fear inside: fear of the future, fear of death, fear that we won't be *good enough*. If you've ever felt that way, today's Gospel is for you. Jesus looks at His friends – who are confused and anxious – and He speaks words that are still medicine for our hearts. Jesus says: *Do not let your hearts be troubled... In my Father's house there are many dwelling places... I am going to prepare a place for you... And I will come back and take you to myself.* (John 14:1-3)

I can still remember the fear that came over me when my doctor suspected cancer. I had a pain in my leg that various medications failed to relieve, and my doctor recommended a CT scan. Fear pierced through every aspect of my life at that time – everything I lived for, and all my plans. I was afraid for my mother – wondering

who would take care of her. This is just one example among many – one that, surely, many of us can call to mind right now. How often is a human life filled with fear and uncertainty?

First, let us notice what Jesus does not say in today's gospel to His disciples. He doesn't say, *There's nothing to worry about*, as if their pain isn't real. He says, *Do not let your hearts be troubled*. In other words: *I know you're afraid. Bring that fear to Me*. Then Jesus says: *I am the way and the*

truth and the life. (John 14:6). He doesn't give His disciples a map. He gives them Himself. When life feels confusing, the Christian answer is not, *Figure it all out*. The Christian answer is, *Stay close to Jesus*.

And maybe that's a good question to ask ourselves: what do I do when I don't know what's coming next? Do I try to control everything? Do I shut down? Jesus invites us to something better. He invites us to take the next step with Him: to pray even when we feel nothing, to come to Mass even when we are distracted, to go to confession even when we are ashamed, to open the Scriptures even when we are tired. Not because those things magically erase problems, but because they keep us connected to the One who is steady when everything else feels shaky. And Jesus frees us from fear in very practical ways. He frees us from the fear that we are alone – because He stays with us. He frees us from the fear of our past –

because He forgives sins. He frees us from the fear that God is against us – because Jesus shows us the Father's heart. If you want to know what God is like, look at Jesus: merciful, patient, close to the brokenhearted.

Jesus also gives us hope. He says He is going to prepare a place for us. That means heaven is not a vague dream. It is a place prepared by Someone who loves us personally. Jesus doesn't just open a door and say, *Good luck*. He promises, *I will come back and take you to myself*. So, when we stand at a hospital bed, when we sit at the kitchen table with a bill we don't know how to pay, when we worry about our children or our parents, we can say, *Lord, You see me. You have not forgotten me. You are not far away*. Christian hope doesn't deny suffering; it puts suffering in the hands of Someone who can carry it.

So don't carry your fear alone. Bring it to the One who died for you, rose for you, and is already preparing the most beautiful place for you. Tell Him plainly what you're afraid of – name it in your prayer. And if you can, share it with someone who will help you carry it: a trusted friend, a family member, a priest. Fear grows in isolation, but it weakens in the light.

Fun Fact about the ART in St MARTHA Church

The Birth of Christ, Nativity

Our stained glass window, *Nativity*, is a familiar scene, but one with a deeper meaning than is perceived at first glance. It is important to understand, as it speaks to the divine light entering the world quietly, recognized only by those willing to see. **God chooses humanity over power.**

The *Nativity* is part of our series (*Annunciation, Visitation, Nativity, Presentation, Finding in the Temple*), depicting the early life of Jesus. *Nativity* is placed between the *Visitation* and the *Presentation*, evoking part of the Joyful Mysteries cycle and making an emotional connection between all three.

Symbolically, in *Nativity*, we see the Christ Child at the center. Notice the bright light, especially to the left, suggesting the light comes from the Child, not the star, the sky, or the flame. Christ is the Light of the World, and the world receives His light for the first time. Mary is in blue, symbolizing the heavens, and white for purity. She is calm and accepting of God's will. Joseph is in brown, representing earthly characteristics, and is off-center and looking downward, protective, but silent in his faith. The star is divine guidance.

The use of stained glass is meant to teach through images. The light passing through the windows represents purity, the heavens, and spirituality. Each hand-painted, crafted stained glass window along the church walls is a piece of art, created in 1941 by the K. J. Mueller Studio of Zephyrhills. Our stained glass windows are historically significant and are included in the 1994 State of Florida Historical Stained Glass Survey. They were restored by Mr Mueller's nephew.

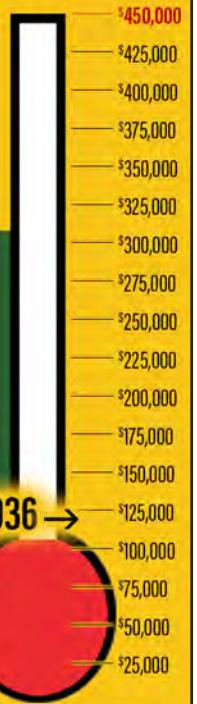



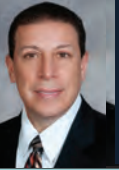
