**May 24, 2026, The Solemnity of Pentecost (Descent of the Holy Spirit) by Father George**

Flames of fire appeared on each apostle in the Cenacle when the Holy Spirit descended on them. A dove was another sign of the Holy Spirit, Who descended on Jesus when John baptized Him. In our churches we always see the image of a dove above our church organs, which reminds us about the presence of the Holy Spirit among us. Another sign of the Spirit is the languages in which the apostles spoke in Jerusalem, and they were understood by many visitors. In St. Martha, it will be American, Polish, Vietnamese, and Italian accents of the parish clergy and many other accents represented by the parishioners and guests who attend the church. This shows that the power of the living Spirit is present in the living Church.

Jesus gave the Church the mission of forgiveness: *whose sins you forgive they are forgiven*. God empowers humans with the strength of the Holy Spirit in order that we humans learn properly how to forgive and how to regain others for God. And we remember how Jesus forgave the thief on the cross, He forgave Peter who denied him, He forgave the sinful woman caught in adultery, He forgave Zacchaeus the tax collector, He taught forgiveness in the story of the prodigal son, He forgave the paralytic whom He also cured, and He forgave

others who suffered from guilt. He now creates His forgiving Church, which now, with the gifts of the Holy Spirit, understands His actions and knows the value of forgiveness and the danger of sin.

Jesus also said;

*for those whose sins you retain, they are retained.* This is not an invitation to His apostles to use a special power to rule the human conscience and punish people for their mistakes. This is to make them and everybody else aware of how dangerous it is living in sin, and how important it is to be forgiven. Retaining sin doesn't mean a refusal of sacramental absolution. It means postponing the sacramental absolution of sin until a penitent realizes the seriousness of sin and decides to turn away from it, like in the case of Peter who denied Jesus yet came back and three times assured Jesus of his love, or other disciples, who ran away from garden of Gethsemane, but who came back and prayed with Mary.

Forgiveness brings peace and peace brings joy; we can clearly see it from this encounter between Jesus and His disciples.

Entering the room, He gave them the gift of peace, which then made them filled with joy, and in turn He gave them the Holy Spirit and told them to combat sin and spread forgiveness.

Today is the first Sunday after the Vatican announced the name of the future Bishop for our Diocese. Bishop Dewane's obligatory resignation has been accepted and Fr. Emilio Biosca Agüero has been named Bishop-elect. He will be consecrated Bishop on

**Notes From Father George:**

**Bishop Frank J. Dewane is retiring**

- When he turned 75 in 2025, Bishop Dewane was obliged by the Canon Law to hand in his resignation from his episcopal ministry. The Holy Father accepted his resignation on May 13, 2026, and Bishop Dewane became Bishop-emeritus in the Diocese of Venice. He is still the Administrator of the Diocese until the new Bishop takes over after his consecration.

The Vatican announced the name of his replacement, who is Bishop-elect **Father Emilio Biosca Agüero**, pastor of the Shrine of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in Washington D.C. The Bishop-elect **will be consecrated Bishop on July 11, 2026**. May God give Bishop Dewane a happy retirement and the Bishop-elect his generous blessing for his episcopal ministry in the Diocese of Venice.

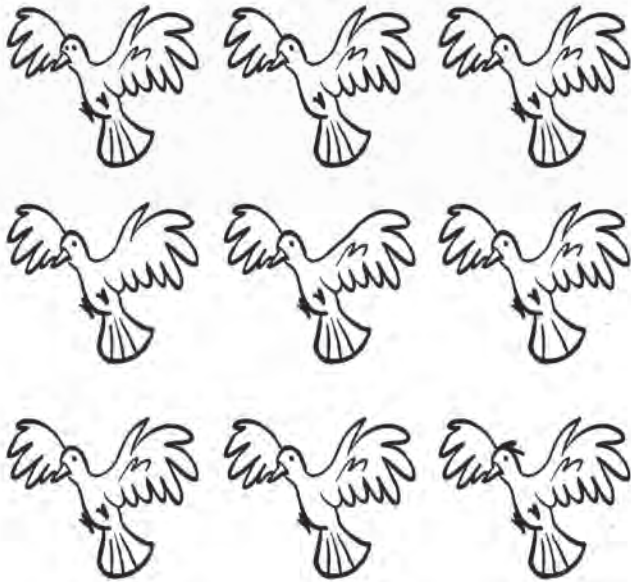

### Information for Families with Students in Catholic School

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that parents receive the responsibility of evangelizing their children and calls them the first heralds of the faith. The family is also called domestic church – the church of the home. It is so important for parents to be strong role models as active Catholics, becoming the primary catechists in the faith development of their children.

In keeping with this important role of parents, there will be two requirements to qualify for the Practicing Catholic Tuition Discount when submitting the Parish Affiliation Form.

**The first requirement** is 50% attendance at Sunday Mass for the year. To confirm your attendance, please place your offertory envelope in the basket during the offertory collection (No contribution is needed inside the envelope).

**The second requirement** is participation in at least one parish ministry.

Please see the list (right) of qualifying ministries for parents, children, and families.

**Ministries for Children**  
**Altar Server** Assigned to serve at a Saturday Vigil Mass or Sunday Mass (training program provided)  
Frequency at least once a month.

**Ministries for Families**  
**Greeters & Offertory Gift Bearers** Before Mass, greet and welcome parishioners/visitors at the main entrance of the church, and during Mass bring offertory gifts to the altar. Frequency once a month.

**Family Ministry**  
Parents and children serve coffee and donuts to parishioners on Sunday morning for a ninety-minute shift between 7am & 1pm.  
Frequency once a month.
