**The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood Of Christ
by Deacon Bob**

The ultimate peak or success in life is to have someone tell us that they genuinely love us. In reality, that is what we all live for, isn't it? The world wants us to believe it requires power, looks, financial wealth to be loved. But Our Lord shares a completely different take about love. Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Jesus' Body and Blood: the Eucharist. In His Body and Blood, Jesus is telling us: *I love you!*

A true agape love which is what we seek, is the highest form of love, and is self-giving, sacrificial, and unconditional. This type of love seeks the good of the one being loved without demand in return. When we receive the Eucharist, we need to hear in His Body and Blood as we receive it, Jesus saying *I love you!* Because He does! He loves us beyond all telling.

Sadly, almost half of Catholics, and pretty much the rest of Christianity, do not realize that the Eucharist IS truly His Body and His Blood. The Eucharist is His true presence. How can a piece of bread (that tastes like bread and looks like bread), and a cup of wine (that tastes like wine and looks like wine) be His Body and Blood? Surely, it must be a metaphor. But if we believe Jesus to be God, (which by the way He is!), it can't be a metaphor based on His teachings and the words HE chooses during those same teachings!

In the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke (referred to as the Synoptic Gospels), Jesus who almost all of the time taught in parables gets pretty specific in the upper room, in what is referred to as the *Institution Narrative* where he says: *This is My Body and This is My Blood*. These same words are recited by the priest in Mass as the bread and

wine are changed into His Body and Blood. Jesus is pretty direct in those lines. Is Jesus wrong? Well He can't be if He is God.

Today's Gospel may be the most compelling teaching of the true presence in the Eucharist. Just prior to what we just heard in today's Gospel, Jesus has fed the five thousand with a few fish and a few loaves of bread. He also has been teaching about life is not about what happens to us, but what we do for others. Between the miracles He has done and the teaching, His message is gaining some serious traction. Then He says something extremely radical! He says His flesh is true food and His blood is true drink. Unless we eat His Body and drink His Blood, we do not have eternal life. This is where today's Gospel verse ends, but what directly follows

cements that the Eucharist IS THE REAL PRESENCE OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST! Those words literally freak out the crowd. They think to themselves, we were all in till now. Now you are talking about cannibalism...brother, you just went off the deep end, and they all start to leave!

But what does Jesus do? He does not run after them saying wait you misunderstood. The Shepard lets the lambs leave. As He said what He meant and meant what He said. They understood exactly what He was saying. In fact, Jesus not only lets them leave, but He also doubles down on His comments to the twelve. He asks Peter and the others are they going to leave Him too? As he is not backing off that His Body is true food and His Blood is true drink.

He does not back away from the Eucharist being His true Body and Blood, because He needs to let us know how much He loves us. With true love, there should be a physical element to it. Sometimes it is a kiss, a hug, in marriage: the marital act. With Jesus, He offers us a physical relationship with God in His Most Holy Body and Blood. In receiving His Body and Blood, we have reached the ultimate success in our lives as Our God is telling us, *I Love you!*

Please Welcome Fr. Walter Garbowski to St Martha Parish

I was born and raised in Poland as one of seven siblings in a devout Catholic family. Both parents and one of my brothers are deceased. Before I entered the Seminary, I was working for two years in the Military as a civil worker. I joined the Pallottine Fathers in 1976 and was ordained on May 2, 1981, as a priest, formed under the pontificate of St. John Paul II. I earned my master's degree from the Catholic University of Lublin and began my priestly ministry with one year in Szczecin, Poland and another in England, where I studied English Language.



In 1983, I moved to Buffalo, New York and became a US citizen in 1988. Even though I joined the Diocese of Buffalo in 1994, I still continue to work closely with Pallottine Fathers in many ways. My early ministry included seven years at Assumption Parish in Buffalo, followed by seven years at Queen of Martyrs in Cheektowaga, where I was active in the Polish American Community. In 2000, I became a pastor of the Immaculate Conception parish in Eden where I spent over seventeen years and at the same time also shepherded the Holy Spirit Parish in North Collins for seven years.

In 2017, I accepted the Bishop's call to serve at St. Gabriel's, one of the Diocese's largest parishes. There were many challenges but with support of God and the parish community I successfully worked for seven years. Throughout my priestly ministry I organized a great support for the missionaries as far as Papua New Guinea, Ecuador, Brazil, Peru, Latvia. The most significantly in the wake of the war in Ukraine I led efforts that raised over \$200k for refugee relief.

I am deeply in love with nature, animals and people of God. In June 2015, I retired from my ministry but still continue to serve in many parishes fulfilling what Bishop Michael Fisher wrote to me accepting my retirement: *Since you are a priest forever, I am certain God's people will continue to enjoy your pastoral care as you minister to them when and where you are able in your retirement years.*

I am so happy to be here in your beautiful church of St. Martha once again accepting new challenges and facing hot summer weather, new people, new opportunities in a ministry and serving all of you. Sarasota and St. Martha is a very beautiful place to be; so let us pray for each other may the Lord guide us and lead us in these coming months ahead.

May the Lord bless you All.

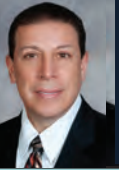
