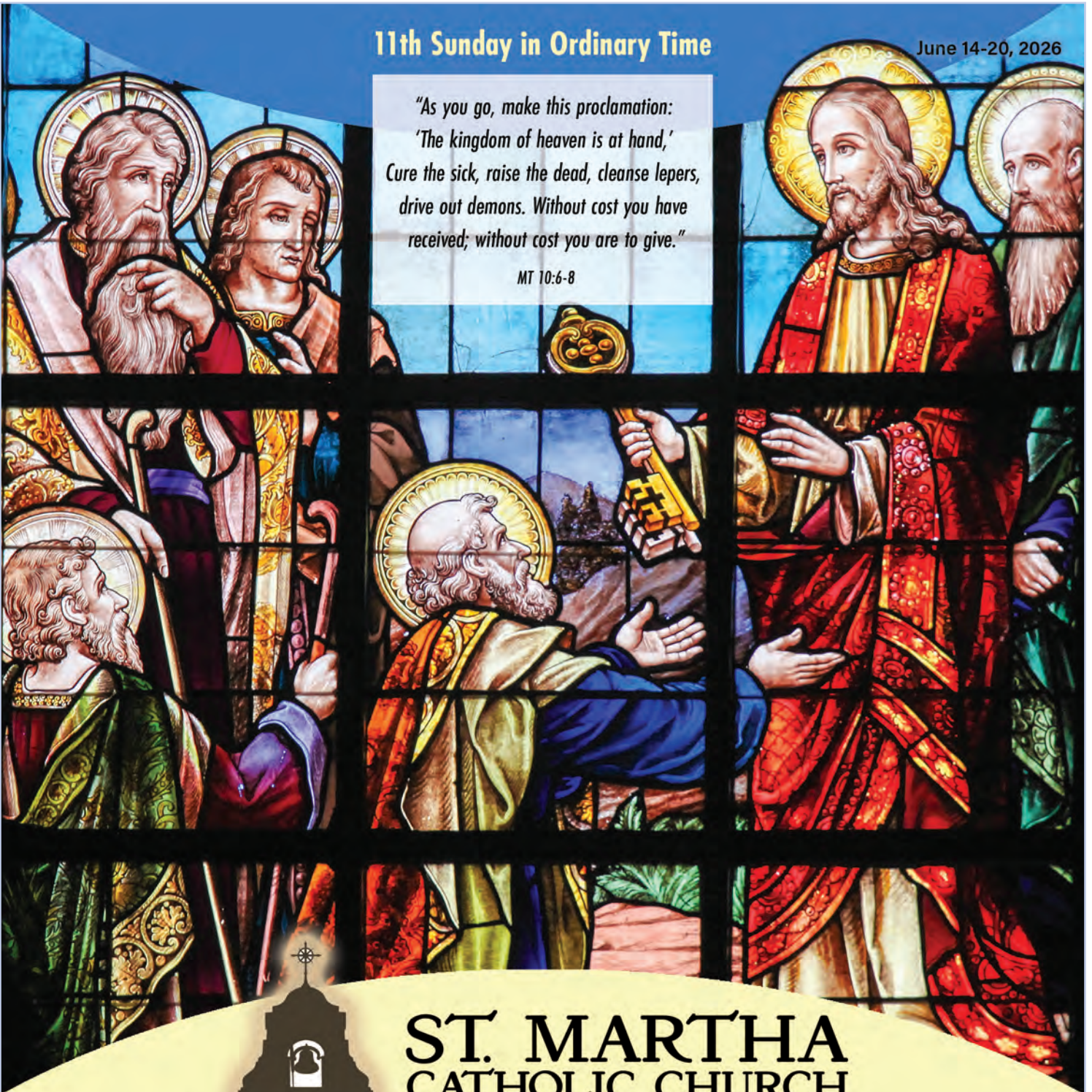

Before the American bishops consecrated the United States of America to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on June 11, Bishop Frank Dewane wrote the letter explaining the meaning. He wrote that it is a part of the celebrations of 250th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence. This Consecration recognized and celebrated the contribution of Catholics and the impact of our faith on the history of the country. It signaled to God that His goodness is not forgotten and that our country relies on God's providence for continued flourishing, bringing blessing and hope to a country suffering from wounds of division and an epidemic of loneliness.

First, he said, that on this occasion we thanked God for His goodness. His goodness was remembered and we recognized that Good God blesses us in our human history.

Secondly, that we, the people of this country, continually need God's providence to lead us and to bless us. This country needs believers who commit themselves to cooperate with the grace of God while building our families and the society with Christian values.

And lastly, we need God's transforming Spirit to heal our divisions and among other things - an epidemic of loneliness. The Devil accuses us constantly and tells us that we are bad, but the Holy

Spirit, the Advocate is the Defender. He consoles us and revives the life of God in us. He heals our spiritual loneliness and brings us back into the community with God and his people. He also helps us when we fall into our physical and social

loneliness, He gives us Church, a community of believers who share joy and goodness.

The gospel tells us that Jesus chose the twelve apostles to give His Church the authority over unclean spirits, the sick, and even the dead. Jesus wants his grace present in the work of his Church and in the body of the Church. Goodness and joy are attractive to others; they help to keep the Church united and joyful. They are good remedies for divisions and loneliness of individuals and for groups of people. Let's ask the Apostles to constantly pray to God for joy and goodness in his Church so that any evil will be overcome.

Invitation to pray to our favorite Apostle - Pray with me please, for the Lord to send laborers to his harvest from our parish, in the similar way he

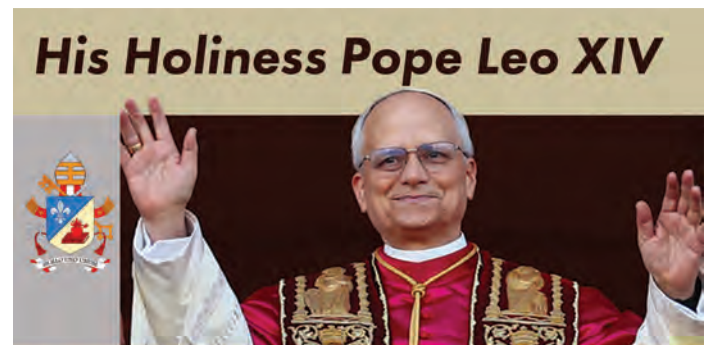

Information for
Families with Students in Catholic School

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that parents receive the responsibility of evangelizing their children and calls them the first heralds of the faith. The family is also called domestic church – the church of the home. It is so important for parents to be strong role models as active Catholics, becoming the primary catechists in the faith development of their children.

In keeping with this important role of parents, there will be two requirements to qualify for the Practicing Catholic Tuition Discount when submitting the Parish Affiliation Form.

The first requirement is 50% attendance at Sunday Mass for the year. To confirm your attendance, please place your offertory envelope in the basket during the offertory collection (No contribution is needed inside the envelope).

The second requirement is participation in at least one parish ministry.

Please see the list (right) of qualifying ministries for parents, children, and families.

Ministries for Children

Altar Server Assigned to serve at a Saturday Vigil Mass or Sunday Mass (training program provided)
Frequency at least once a month.

Ministries for Families

Greeters & Offertory Gift Bearers Before Mass, greet and welcome parishioners/visitors at the main entrance of the church, and during Mass bring offertory gifts to the altar. Frequency once a month.

Family Ministry

Parents and children serve coffee and donuts to parishioners on Sunday morning for a ninety-minute shift between 7am & 1pm.
Frequency once a month.

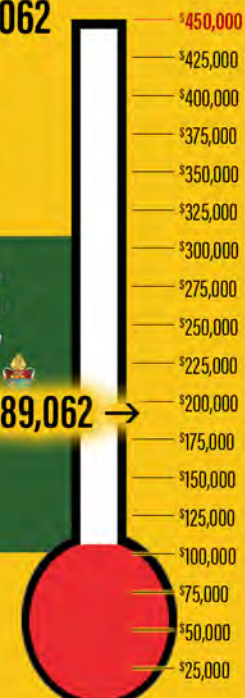

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA (AMS) was created to ensure that Catholic military personnel received the full range of pastoral services, including access to the sacraments and spiritual guidance.

The Catholic chaplains and deacons of AMS provide pastoral care to over a million Catholics serving in the US Armed Forces, their family members, students at the Military Academies, patients at Veterans Affairs medical centers and federal personnel working abroad.

Years of wars have placed many hardships on military personnel and their family members, and they rely on our Catholic chaplains for spiritual guidance and support. However, there is a severe shortage of Catholic chaplains in the Archdiocese for the Military Services, which results in our military men and women not having access to the sacraments or spiritual guidance for months at a time.

The Diocese of Venice will take up a collection for AMS on the weekend of June 13 and 14, 2026. 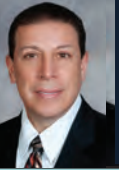

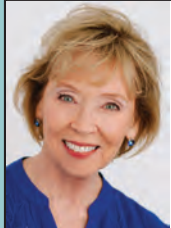
