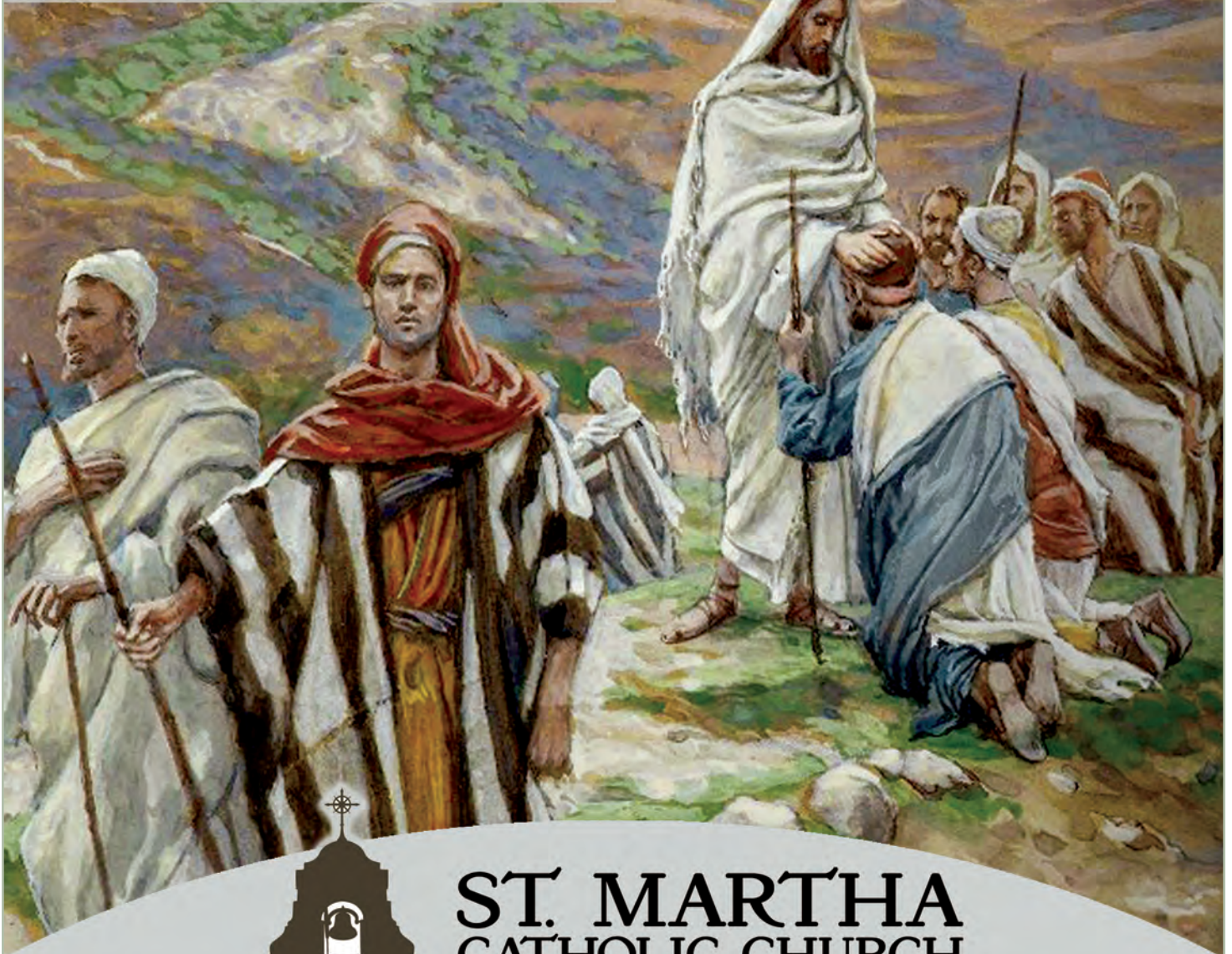

June 21, 2026 - 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The readings for this Sunday speak powerfully about fear, trust, and the courage to witness to God's truth in a world that can be hostile. They invite us to move from anxiety to confidence, from silence to bold proclamation, rooted in the assurance that God knows us intimately and never abandons us.

In the Gospel (Matthew 10:26-33), Jesus tells His disciples three times: *Do not be afraid*. This repetition reveals how deeply fear can grip the human heart. The disciples are being sent into a world that will misunderstand, oppose, and even persecute them. Yet Jesus reminds them that nothing is hidden forever – truth will ultimately prevail.

This message is not just for the apostles; it is for us. We often fear rejection, failure, or being judged for our beliefs. We might hesitate to speak about our faith or live it fully in public. But Jesus reassures us that God's providence is active in every detail of our lives. Even *the hairs of your head are all counted*. This intimate care means we are never alone or forgotten.

The first reading (Jeremiah 20:10-13) shows the raw human experience of fear and suffering. Jeremiah feels surrounded by enemies and betrayal. He even hears whispering voices plotting against him. Yet in the middle of this anguish, he proclaims a profound truth:

But the Lord is with me, like a mighty champion.

Jeremiah teaches us that faith does not mean the absence of fear – it means choosing to trust God despite fear. His journey reflects our own: moments of doubt and discouragement can coexist with deep trust. God does not expect us to be fearless; He invites us to rely on Him when we are afraid.

In the second reading (Romans 5:12-15), St. Paul contrasts Adam and Christ. Sin entered the world through one man, bringing death. But through Jesus, grace overflows even more abundantly. This passage reminds us that no matter how broken the world may seem, God's grace is always greater than sin.

This is crucial when we face fear or opposition. The ultimate victory has already been won by Christ. We do not struggle alone, and we do not struggle in vain. Every act of faith, every witness to truth, participates in the triumph of grace over darkness. Jesus' final words in the Gospel challenge us directly:

"Everyone who acknowledges Me before others I will acknowledge before My heavenly Father.

Faith is not meant to be hidden. It is meant to shine. This does not always require dramatic gestures; often it is lived in quiet fidelity, integrity at work, compassion in relationships, and courage in speaking truth when it is difficult.

At the same time, Jesus warns about denying Him. This is not meant to threaten us, but to remind us of the importance of

Solemnity of St. Peter and St. Paul - (June 29) Next week, Monday is the day to remember these two Princes of the Church, who followed Jesus, and they both ended their lives as martyrs for Jesus in Rome. Roman Church is watered with the blood of these two apostles and hundreds of other martyrs, persecuted for believing in Christ.

Next Sunday, June 28, 2026, is the 13th Sunday in ordinary Time.

authenticity. Our relationship with Christ calls for consistency between what we believe and how we live.

This Sunday calls us to reflect: What am I afraid of?

- Fear of rejection?
- Fear of failure?
- Fear of standing out because of my faith?

Jesus speaks directly into those fears: *Do not be afraid*. Our worth is not determined by others' opinions but by God's love. We are precious to Him, more than *many sparrows*.

When we truly grasp this, fear loses its power. We can live with freedom, speak with courage, and love with generosity.

The 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time reminds us that discipleship involves both challenge and grace. Like Jeremiah, we may feel surrounded by difficulties. Like the apostles, we may face fear. But like St. Paul teaches, grace is always greater than anything we encounter.

Let us ask for the courage to trust God deeply, to witness to Christ boldly, and to remember always:

We are known, we are loved, and we need not be afraid.

Information for
Families with Students in Catholic School

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that parents receive the responsibility of evangelizing their children and calls them the first heralds of the faith. The family is also called domestic church – the church of the home. It is so important for parents to be strong role models as active Catholics, becoming the primary catechists in the faith development of their children.

In keeping with this important role of parents, there will be two requirements to qualify for the Practicing Catholic Tuition Discount when submitting the Parish Affiliation Form.

The first requirement is 50% attendance at Sunday Mass for the year. To confirm your attendance, please place your offertory envelope in the basket during the offertory collection (No contribution is needed inside the envelope).

The second requirement is participation in at least one parish ministry.

Altar Server Assigned to serve at a Saturday Vigil Mass or Sunday Mass (training program provided)
 Frequency at least once a month.

Ministries for Families
Greeters & Offertory Gift Bearers Before Mass, greet and welcome parishioners/visitors at the main entrance of the church, and during Mass bring offertory gifts to the altar. Frequency once a month.

Family Ministry
 Parents and children serve coffee and donuts to parishioners on Sunday morning for a ninety-minute shift between 7am & 1pm.
