A Polish Philosophers and publicist wrote this about God's Providence: *The Divine Providence, is universal, direct, and particular.*

Divine Providence is Universal - it doesn't want to exclude anyone. People of different opinions and cultures can receive the Divine grace and protection. Divine Providence is above exclusion zones, various borders, lock-down regions or cities and margins of society. Universal Divine Providence takes care of all children of God, no matter who and where they are. This refers to the gospel weeds growing with wheat and God allowing it to grow.

Divine Providence is Direct - it speaks to us personally heart to

heart. It doesn't depend on any institution, political allegiance or influencers. Our Church in this regard is also rather a field of wheat than the harvester. It opens or even creates the ways of spiritual encounters with God; it doesn't judge who is closer to God. This is decided by God who comes to each person and by the response of this person. The Church can help us to respond to God. At harvest time - when God comes to every individual or calls every individual to himself - God will be direct with his judgment.

Divine Providence is Particular - it comes to us even in the smallest need. Even in today's global world, God's Providence takes care of our personal needs and challenges. We can pray to God for our personal needs: family, job, health, and many others so called small things. Our generalizations and globalist attitudes may not be the high priority for God's Providence, but our concerns, feelings, personal experiences, and needs are high priority, and weeds will not disturb God's love for us. The evil people will be judged fairly.

In the Gospel, Jesus said that God knows that bad weeds were sown among the good seeds by an enemy, yet He doesn't want to remove them in case the wheat will be pulled up with them. He leaves it for the harvest time when He will separate the weeds for burning and gather the wheat into a barn. This parable speaks about God's

Information for Families with Students in Catholic School

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that parents receive the responsibility of evangelizing their children and calls them the first heralds of the faith. The family is also called domestic church — the church of the home. It is so important for parents to be strong role models as active Catholics, becoming the primary catechists in the faith development of their children.

In keeping with this important role of parents, there will be two requirements to qualify for the Practicing Catholic Tuition Discount when submitting the Parish Affiliation Form.

The first requirement is 50% attendance at Sunday Mass for the year. To confirm your attendance, please place your offertory envelope in the basket during the offertory collection (No contribution is needed inside the envelope).

The second requirement is participation in at least one parish ministry.

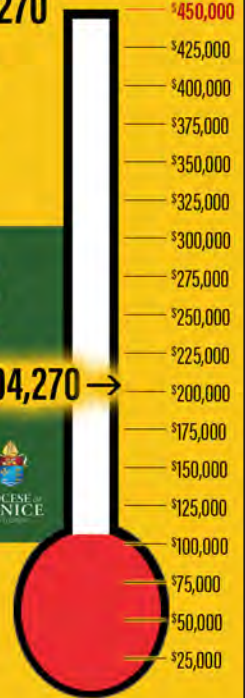

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On June 24, 2026, two consecutive earthquakes of 7.2 and 7.5 magnitudes struck northern Venezuela. In recent days, all of us have seen heart wrenching images and videos of the damage and human toll of this disaster. These pictures show us parents searching for missing children, rescue teams digging through rubble, and everywhere people picking up the pieces.

These "doublet" earthquakes have caused grave and extensive devastation throughout the region, with over 2,000 confirmed deaths and thousands missing at this time. Further, there are many thousands of individuals who have been injured, and countless homes and other buildings have been damaged and destroyed.

Our Lord calls each of us to care for our brothers and sisters in need, and, at this time in particular, for those who are suffering in the wake of this terrible tragedy.

Recognizing the need of those who have been so severely impacted by the earthquakes as well as to inquiries regarding the Diocese's response, a second collection will be held throughout the Diocese of Venice on the weekend of July 25-26, which will be sent to assist in recovery.

Your generosity for the people of Venezuela is deeply appreciated. Regardless of your generous response of assistance, please continue to pray for all who are suffering as a result of this terrible disaster, as well as for those who have lost their lives.

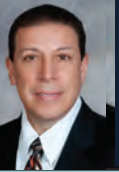
