by Deacon Bob - Mt 13: 44-52

For many years I was not a fan of the band Led Zeppelin. I had bought into the urban legends of them being satanists and was not particularly fond of their lifestyles. But a great friend of mine, Bill, who was a West Point Grad and an amazing man (who has since passed away), convinced me to at least just listen to them and what their lyrics said. He said see for yourself. So I did. One song's lyrics stunned me. It was their most famous song, Stairway to Heaven. Today's Gospel is very much reflected in that song.

Today's Gospel again focuses on Jesus' parables. The first two are about what we value in our earthly life. Basically, what should our stairway to Heaven be? The question is, what is our treasure? What

are we willing to sell to get it? And are we willing to give it the urgency that the effort to attain it requires? In the first parable, a person finds a treasure, then sells everything to get it (the treasure). In the second parable, the store owner knows what is valuable (the pearl), then hunts for it, and once he finds it, he also sells everything

to attain it. So the question becomes, again, what is our treasure? Is it the same treasure as the people in the Gospel or the lady sung about in the opening lines of Stairway to Heaven?

The song starts out, *there's a lady who's sure all that glitters is gold and she's buying the stairway to heaven*. She thinks financial wealth is where happiness dwells. She believes even when doors are closed, with power and gold she can still get what she came for. Today's Gospel completely rejects that! Jesus today is telling us the Kingdom of Heaven is priceless! He is telling us the lady that the song is referencing is on a fool's bet. If we, like her, think that *all that glitters is gold*, we are destined to sadness and disappointment.

The song provides a juxtaposition with the lady. There is a second lady it talks about. It is a *lady we all know who shines white light and wants to show how everything turns to gold* (the Blessed Mom?). Today Jesus is telling us that is truly the case. There is a treasure! But that treasure is not what the world tells us it is. The treasure resides in the arms of Jesus.

The third parable today reminds us that, like a fisherman casting his net into the sea, we will be sorted out as whether we purchased a true stairway to Heaven, or we did not. Today, Jesus calls us to pick the correct treasure. Last Sunday we heard a parable about

Notes From Father George:

Pastoral Improvement - We need to ask parishioners/visitors who sit in the first pew on the left-hand side of the church, in front of the Ambo, to go and receive Communion from a Deacon or a Minister, who will be standing next to a Priest. Deacon or Minister will no longer give out Communion to whoever sits in that pew.

If you are Disabled or want to receive Communion while kneeling, you should sit on the right-hand side in the two pews facing the side of the sanctuary or in the first pew facing the front of the sanctuary. A Priest or Deacon will distribute Communion there.

July 29, 2026 - Memorial of St. Martha - Patron Saint of our parish. Let's pray through her intercession: *O Blessed Saint Martha your faith led Jesus to proclaim, I am the resurrection and the life; and faith let you see beyond His humanity when you cried out, Lord I believe that you are the Messiah, the Son of God. With firm hope you said, I know that God will give you whatever you ask of Him, and Jesus called your brother Lazarus back from the dead. With pure love for Jesus, you welcomed Him into your home. Friend and servant of our Saviour, I too am troubled about many things, pray for me that I may grow in faith, hope and love, and that Jesus, who sat at your table, will hear me and grant me a place at the banquet of eternal life.*

Anointing of the Sick - We invite any sick person to come to our church on Wednesday, July 29 at 9am for the Sacrament of Anointing. Together with St. Martha - patroness of our church and with St. Mary and Lazarus her siblings we will pray for God's healing and mercy.

Next Sunday, August 2, 2026, is the 18th Sunday in ordinary Time.

allowing the weeds to grow with the wheat. It was not to be sorted out till harvest time, because, like the song Stairway to Heaven reminds us, *there are two paths we can go by, but in the long run, there is still time to change the road you're on!*

Today He calls us to be like the two people in the parables and pick the true treasure: the treasure to be with the One who loves us beyond all telling. He asks us to pick the treasure to be with God who is only focused on His love for us. He calls us to buy (with our Faith, Hope and Love) the REAL stairway to Heaven.

Information for Families with Students in Catholic School

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that parents receive the responsibility of evangelizing their children and calls them the first heralds of the faith. The family is also called domestic church — the church of the home. It is so important for parents to be strong role models as active Catholics, becoming the primary catechists in the faith development of their children.

In keeping with this important role of parents, there will be two requirements to qualify for the Practicing Catholic Tuition Discount when submitting the Parish Affiliation Form.

The first requirement is 50% attendance at Sunday Mass for the year. To confirm your attendance, please place your offertory envelope in the basket during the offertory collection (No contribution is needed inside the envelope).

The second requirement is participation in at least one parish ministry.

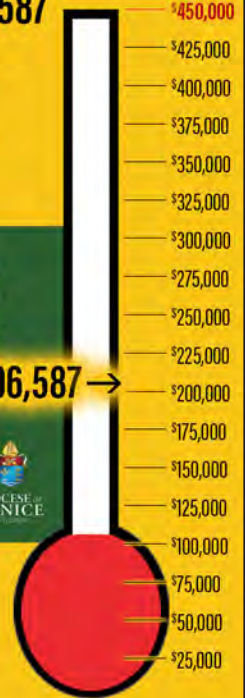

A Message from BISHOP EMERITUS DEWANE



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On June 24, 2026, two consecutive earthquakes of 7.2 and 7.5 magnitudes struck northern Venezuela. In recent days, all of us have seen heart wrenching images and videos of the damage and human toll of this disaster. These pictures show us parents searching for missing children, rescue teams digging through rubble, and everywhere people picking up the pieces.

These "doublet" earthquakes have caused grave and extensive devastation throughout the region, with over 2,000 confirmed deaths and thousands missing at this time. Further, there are many thousands of individuals who have been injured, and countless homes and other buildings have been damaged and destroyed.

Our Lord calls each of us to care for our brothers and sisters in need, and, at this time in particular, for those who are suffering in the wake of this terrible tragedy.

Recognizing the need of those who have been so severely impacted by the earthquakes as well as to inquiries regarding the Diocese's response, a second collection will be held throughout the Diocese of Venice on the weekend of July 25-26, which will be sent to assist in recovery.

Your generosity for the people of Venezuela is deeply appreciated. Regardless of your generous response of assistance, please continue to pray for all who are suffering as a result of this terrible disaster, as well as for those who have lost their lives.

I take this opportunity to extend to you the assurances of my continued consideration, as well as my prayers.

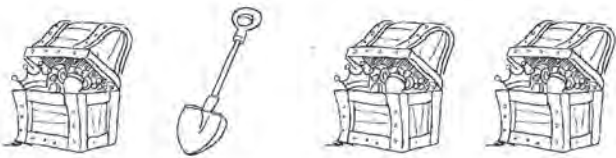

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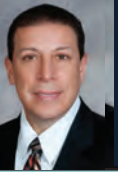
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
