August 9, 2026 by Father Gennadi 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Mt 14, 22-33

Today's Gospel places us in a boat at night. The disciples are tired, the wind is against them, and the waves are strong. Then Jesus comes to them, walking on the water. Peter wants to come to Him, and for a moment he does. But when Peter looks at the wind, fear enters his heart and he begins to sink. Then he cries out with one short prayer: *Lord, save me!* Peter does not explain everything. He only cries from his heart, *Lord, save me!* And immediately Jesus reaches out His hand. This is the message for us today. Most of us will never walk on water. God may not remove every storm from our life. But with His grace, in every difficult situation, we can make a good decision and persevere in doing good.

Saint Sister Faustina understood this very well. In her Diary, she describes a painful situation. Someone spoke against her, and the trouble grew like a storm. She felt that she did not have enough strength to bear it calmly. So, she went before the Blessed Sacrament and prayed, *Lord Jesus, I ask You to give me the strength of Your actual grace, because I feel that I will not manage to survive this struggle. Shield me with Your breast.* Then she heard Jesus say, *Do not fear; I am with you.*

This is the bridge between the Gospel and our daily life. Peter was sinking in the water. Faustina was suffering in her heart. We also

have our storms: sickness, family problems, fear about the future, loneliness, temptation, anger, hurt, addictions, or the feeling that we cannot go on. At those moments, we should not depend only on our own strength. We should cry out like Peter and pray like Faustina: *Lord, save me. Give me Your grace now. Help me to do what is right.*

This week, on Friday, we remember Saint Maximilian Kolbe. He was in Auschwitz, a place of hatred, fear, hunger, and death. When a prisoner, Franciszek Gajowniczek, was chosen to die and cried out for his wife and children, Father Kolbe stepped forward and asked to take his place. In a place that looked like hell, he made a beautiful decision: he chose love. He chose to save another person's life. And even in the starvation bunker, stripped naked, amidst hunger and the stifling stench, where death was all around, he persevered in doing good, praying and strengthening others until the end.

Maybe we will never be asked to do something as heroic as Saint Maximilian Kolbe. But every day we are asked to choose good in smaller ways. When someone hurts us, will we answer with hatred or with patience? When we are tired, will we still be kind? When doing the right thing is painful, will we still do it? These are our

Bishop Emilio Biosca visit in St. Martha

- Bishop Emilio requested meetings with clergy in their parishes, and he has been going around the Diocese spending mornings or afternoons with priests and deacons in their parishes. Florida Catholic Newspaper informs that in some parishes Bishop also meets parishioners. The Bishop will come to St. Martha's on Thursday, August 13, in the afternoon to meet nine members of St.

Martha's clergy, active and retired. Bishop Emilio is also going to do parish visitations and that will be a chance to organize Parish Mass, Parish Council, and Finance Committee meeting, and if he agrees, an open parish meeting with parishioners. Bishop is also planning to visit our school.

New School Year - We have celebrated Mass with teachers and staff in St. Martha Primary and in St. Mary Academy just last Monday. The teachers are ready and the students started school this week. May God bless them all, including parents! May St. Martha and St. Mary pray for them and may Guardian Angels grant them safety and joy.

Assumption is not a holy day of obligation this year! - Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into heaven, falls on Saturday, August 15. We will celebrate it with 7:30am and 8:30am Masses.

Pastoral Improvement - We need to ask parishioners/visitors who sit in the first pew on the left-hand side of the church, in front of the Ambo, to go and receive Communion from a Deacon or a Minister, who will be standing next to a Priest. Deacon or Minister will no longer give out Communion to whoever sits in that pew.

If you are Disabled or want to receive Communion while kneeling, you should sit on the right-hand side in the two pews facing the side of the sanctuary or in the first pew facing the front of the sanctuary. A Priest or Deacon will distribute Communion there.

Next Sunday, August 16, 2026, is the 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time.

storms. And Jesus is near.

Grace does not always make life easy. Sometimes the good decision is very painful. Forgiving can be painful. Staying faithful can be painful. Telling the truth can be painful. Continuing to love when there is hatred around us can be painful. But grace gives us strength to take the next step. Grace helps us not to sink. Grace helps us to persevere in doing good even when darkness is around us.

So today, let us remember one prayer: *Lord, save me!* Say it when you are afraid. Say it when you are angry. Say it when you are tempted. Say it when you feel weak. Jesus will stretch out His hand. He will give you the grace you need: not always to escape the storm, but to remain faithful inside the storm. Lord Jesus, when we begin to sink, save us. Give us Your grace. Help us make good decisions. Help us persevere in doing good.

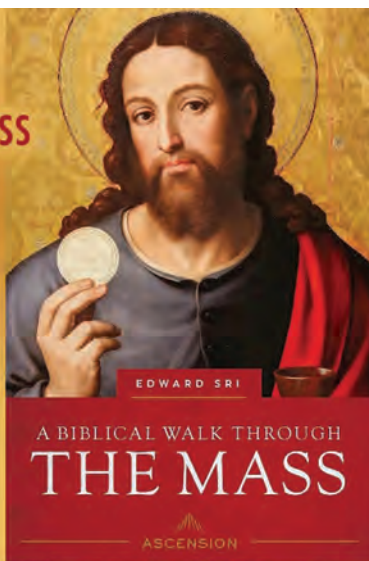

Information for Families with Students in Catholic School

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that parents receive the responsibility of evangelizing their children and calls them the first heralds of the faith. The family is also called domestic church — the church of the home. It is so important for parents to be strong role models as active Catholics, becoming the primary catechists in the faith development of their children.

In keeping with this important role of parents, there will be two requirements to qualify for the Practicing Catholic Tuition Discount when submitting the Parish Affiliation Form.

The first requirement is 50% attendance at Sunday Mass for the year. To confirm your attendance, please place your offertory envelope in the basket during the offertory collection (No contribution is needed inside the envelope).

The second requirement is participation in at least one parish ministry.

Please see the list (right) of qualifying ministries for parents, children, and families.

Ministries for Children

Altar Server Assigned to serve at a Saturday Vigil Mass or Sunday Mass (training program provided)
Frequency at least once a month.

Ministries for Families

Greeters & Offertory Gift Bearers Before Mass, greet and welcome parishioners/visitors at the main entrance of the church, and during Mass bring offertory gifts to the altar. Frequency once a month.

Family Ministry

Parents and children serve coffee and donuts to parishioners on Sunday morning for a ninety-minute shift between 7am & 1pm.
Frequency once a month.

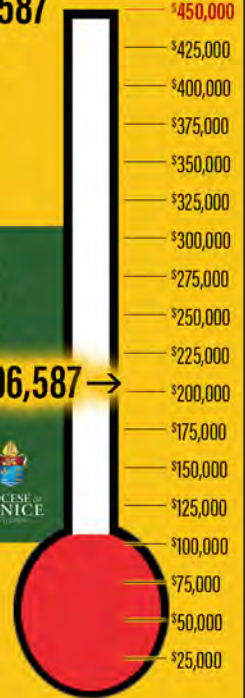

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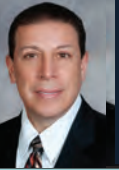

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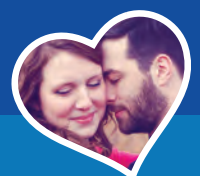
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
