Who do we say that the Son of Man is? Do we really believe Jesus is the Christ? Do we believe that Jesus is the Son of The Living God, the Word made Flesh? If we truly do, then we need to be honest with ourselves. If we accept Jesus as God and Our Savior, then ALL He says is the Truth and not opinion or debatable. Only if we think we are superior to His knowledge can we reject, parse, or ignore His teachings and sayings. He either is or is not. There is no third option. This is as binary as it comes. There is no gray to be found here.

In today's Gospel Jesus asks His Apostles who do the people say the Son of Man is? They give various answers, attributing the polling to other prophets. He then asks the Apostles, *but Who do YOU say that I am?* Simon (who is transformed into the rock or Peter in this conversation), recognizes Jesus for exactly who He is and tells Our Lord that He is the Christ. From that moment on, Our Lord now begins to develop His Church. And it is the Catholic Church with St. Peter our first Pope as His leader. (BTW: there are references as early as 107-110AD pointing to the authority of the Bishop of Rome, now called the Pope, as the leader of the Church, but that will be for another conversation).

Yet sometimes we doubt the authority of the Catholic Church, even though Jesus Himself in today's Gospel gives it the authority through the Chair of Peter. We find ourselves saying *yeah we like*

this teaching, but these other ones seem hard, so we are rejecting them. In those times, whether we realize it or not, we are rejecting Jesus as the Son of God and the Christ! We find ourselves rejecting the authority of St. John Paul 2 or Pope Benedict XVI because they were too orthodox, or we reject Pope Francis or Leo, because they were or are too progressive. But Jesus gave them the authority!

When we fall into the trap of rejecting the teachings of the Church, we are rejecting Jesus. We try to fall back to the Bible and base our rejections on (our misinterpretations of) the Bible. The Bible is only one of three pillars of truth, along with the Magisterium (with the Pope as the head), and Sacred Tradition. So, while the Bible is an absolute truth, so are the other two, based on today's Gospel passage. And while it is an ABSOLUTE Truth, it was compiled beginning in or around 382AD at the Council of Rome and formalized at the Council of Hippo (393), and Carthage (397, 419)! The Bible was not compiled until over 350 years after Jesus died on the cross for us.

What parents would bear children, hand them an instruction book and leave, let alone not provide access to the instruction book until

they were already young adults? Yet for us to reject the Church and its teachings and fall back only on the Bible, that is exactly what we are saying when we reject the Catholic Church's teachings. The Magisterium and Sacred Tradition do not conflict with Sacred Scripture but help define it.

The teachings that are fundamental to the Church start with the Sacraments. Of course, the *source and summit* of our faith is the Eucharist. It really is His Body and Blood, if we accept Jesus as the Christ: for He said it was, and the Church to whom He gave the authority to teach the same. Secondly, He came to take away the sins of the world. For again He said it, and the Church teaches it. And in today's Gospel, He commits Himself (the Son of the living God), to taking away our sins when he tells Peter that he has the power to free us from our sins by giving him and all our priests the ability to forgive sins.

If we accept today's Gospel and that Jesus is the Son of God, we realize that He is always with us in spirit and physically. Physically in His most precious Body and Blood, and in His Holy Catholic Church. Today's Gospel proves if we believe Jesus is God, He gave us this Church to let us know He IS with us ALWAYS! If we say Jesus is the Son of God, we need to listen to Him, receive His Body and Blood, and receive the grace of confession!

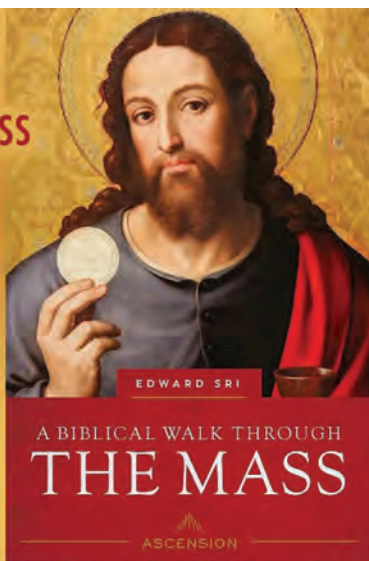

Information for Families with Students in Catholic School

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that parents receive the responsibility of evangelizing their children and calls them the first heralds of the faith. The family is also called domestic church — the church of the home. It is so important for parents to be strong role models as active Catholics, becoming the primary catechists in the faith development of their children.

In keeping with this important role of parents, there will be two requirements to qualify for the Practicing Catholic Tuition Discount when submitting the Parish Affiliation Form.

The first requirement is 50% attendance at Sunday Mass for the year. To confirm your attendance, please place your offertory envelope in the basket during the offertory collection (No contribution is needed inside the envelope).

The second requirement is participation in at least one parish ministry.

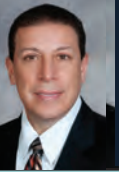

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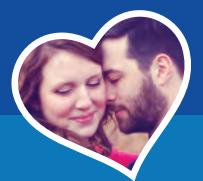
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
