Today Jesus teaches us how to correct someone who has sinned. This is not easy. We do not like to correct others, and we do not like to be corrected. But Jesus does not want us to ignore sin or shame people. He shows us a better way: the way of love.

The Gospel says: *If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have won over your brother.* Jesus begins with privacy. He tells us to go to the person first. Do not begin with gossip. Begin face to face, with respect.

St. John Chrysostom says: *Admonition is not an accusation; it is a medicine. It is not an arraignment, but a remedy. Do not, therefore, demand an account, nor berate him, nor punish him, but heal him.* So how can we correct someone as people of faith? When we correct someone, we are not there to win a case or prove that we are better. We are there to help a brother or sister return to the right path. Before I correct another person, I should ask myself: Am I speaking because I love this person? Do I want peace and healing? If my heart is angry or proud, even true words can wound deeply.

St. Augustine gives us the heart of Christian correction: *Love, and*

"Owe nothing to anyone, except to love one another."

- St. Paul

do what you want... If you are silent, keep silent for love. If you speak, speak for love. If you correct, correct for love. Love must guide what we say, how we say it, and when we say it. Sometimes love is gentle. Sometimes love must be firm. But it must always be love.

St. Paul says: *Owe nothing to anyone, except to love one another.* Love does not

mean pretending that sin is not sin. Love means wanting the good of the other person. If someone is walking toward danger, love says, *I care about you. I do not want you to be lost.*

Jesus gives us a careful path. First, speak privately. If that does not help, take one or two others to help bring truth and peace. Even then, the goal is not revenge. The goal is conversion, healing, and communion.

Bosco, one must admonish others in such a way that they feel loved, never condemned. This is a simple test for us. After I speak, will the person feel invited to return, or only judged? Will the person see that I love?

We cannot control how another person receives our words. But we can control our heart, our tone, and our intention. We can pray before we speak. We can choose the right time. We can tell the truth without humiliating anyone.

At the end of the Gospel, Jesus says: *Where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.* Jesus is present when we seek peace, truth, forgiveness, and unity. He is present when brothers and sisters speak the truth with love.

Towards the end of her life, my mother would often say to me, *Giena, be a good man.* It was one of the last pieces of advice I heard from her. It was simple, but I will remember it for the rest of my life, because she always said it with love. Let us ask God for the courage to speak when love requires it, the humility to speak without pride, and the grace to correct others in such a way that they feel loved, not condemned.

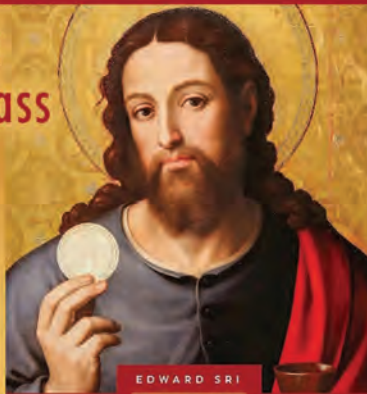

Information for **Families with Students** in Catholic School

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that parents receive the responsibility of evangelizing their children and calls them the first heralds of the faith. The family is also called domestic church – the church of the home. It is so important for parents to be strong role models as active Catholics, becoming the primary catechists in the faith development of their children.

In keeping with this important role of parents there will be two requirements to qualify for the Practicing Catholic Tuition Discount when submitting the Parish Affiliation Form.

The first requirement is 50% attendance at Sunday Mass for the year. To confirm your attendance, please place your offertory envelope in the basket during the offertory collection (No contribution is needed inside the envelope).

The second requirement is participation in at least one parish ministry.

Frequency at least once a month.

Ministries for Families

Virtues, Explained!

Most commonly, we understand the term *vindication* in a very legal, argumentative context. We say someone is *vindicated* when they are proven innocent, or when their good name is defended from an accusation. This isn't so far from what vindication means in the sense of virtue, either. Vindication is related to the virtue of justice, which demands we honor our duty to God and to one another. Justice seeks to ensure the fairness of human interaction. It seeks to safeguard truth against those who would co-opt it for their own purposes. If we truly put our trust in God and seek to do His will, we may not always have popularity, but we will have truth: *Commit your way to the Lord, trust in Him and He will act, and make your righteousness shine like the dawn, your justice like noonday.* (Psalm 37:5-6)

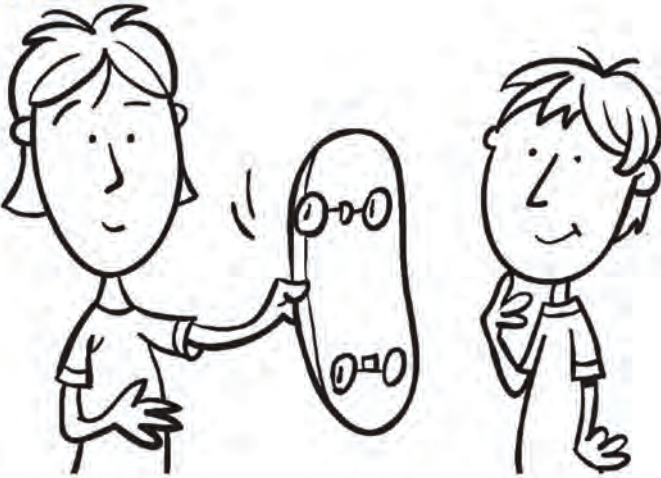

Our students have been enjoying God's creation in so many ways! Third grade spent time learning in our garden, while first grade celebrated the beauty of creation through their special projects.

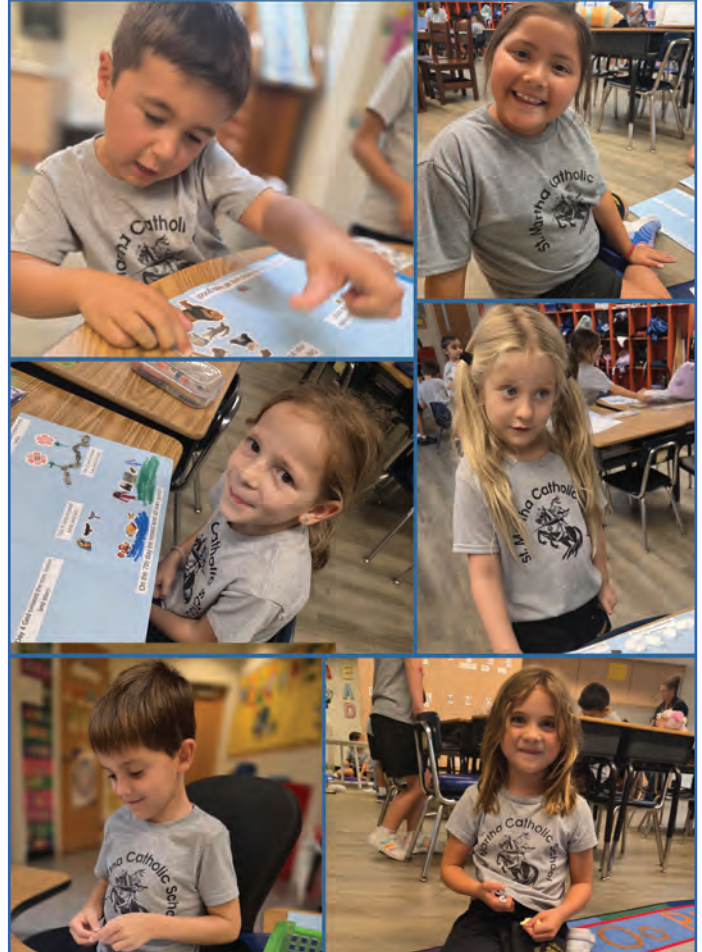

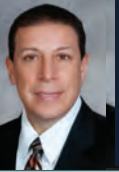

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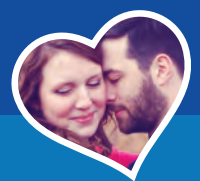
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
